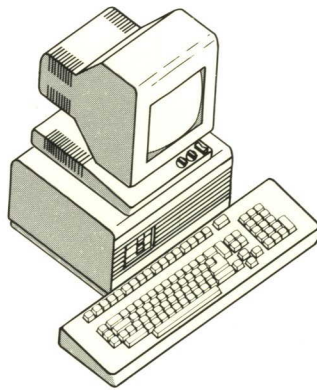
Freedom to make your own decisions based on your plans for the future. That's what the Fortune 1000 is all about.

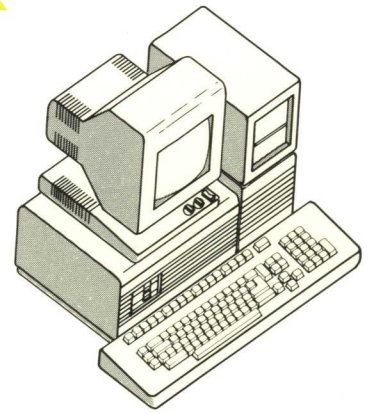




At the lowest end of the spectrum, our affordably priced basic workstation works with our existing 32:16 central processing unit. It allows you to carry out your basic tasks — from word processing to financial spreadsheets. And the new, larger 14-inch screen and ergonomically designed keyboard make it even easier to use.



For the times when letters and numbers just won't say it the way charts, graphs and other graphic representations will, the Fortune 1000 is quick on the draw. With the addition of different options, the basic workstation becomes a monochrome graphics terminal.
