KICKSTART IRRIGATION PUMP

Small-scale African farmers simply do not irrigate; they grow their crops during the one or two rainy season and hope to earn enough money and produce enough food to last through the long dry seasons.

How does it work: KickStart's human-powered "MoneyMaker" irrigation pumps are very low-cost (\$35 and \$100) pumps sold in local retail shops. They enable poor famers to move from rain-fed, subsistence agriculture to commercial irrigated farming. The pumps pull water from shallow wells (as much as 30 feet deep), rivers or ponds and pressurize it thru a hosepipe (like a garden hose) to efficiently irrigate up to two acres of land. The farmers can then grow high-value fruits and vegetables, and sell them throughout the year. During dry seasons, when a scarcity of crops on the market inflates prices, the farmers who irrigate can turn significant profits. On average they increase their net annual incomes by over \$1,000, and this small increase (at least by Western standards) allows for them to take their families out of poverty forever.
