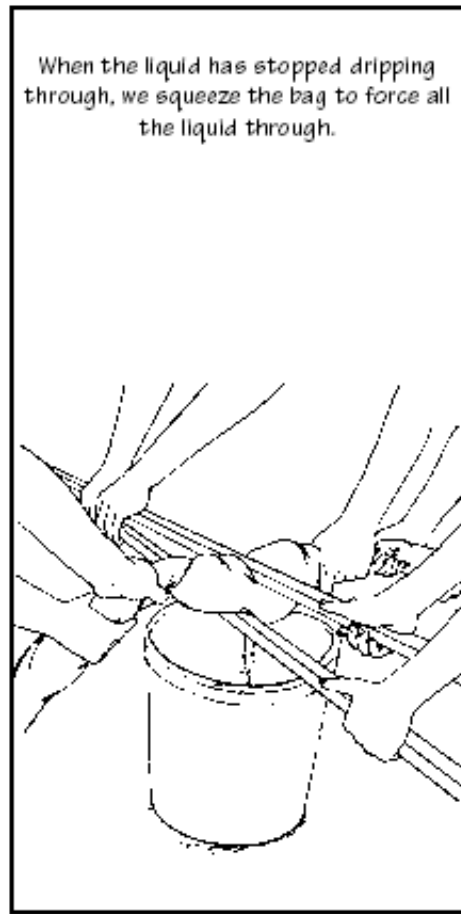
We take all the pieces of comb and put them in the cooking pot with water. Then we heat up the pot until the comb has melted. Be careful not to let the water boil.
