WORMS WORK WONDERS IN NO-TILL

If you ever wondered what kind of impact earthworms can have on your no-till fields, check out these numbers produced by worms castings:

***Nitrogen produced = 9.4 pounds per acre per year.**

***Phosphorus produced = 70.56 pounds per acre per year.**

***Potassium produced = 169.34 pounds per acre per year.**

***Magnesium produced = 211.68 pounds per acre per year.**

***Calcium produced = 1,176 pounds per acre per year.**

***Nitrogen from worm attrition = 5,460 pounds per acre.**

***Nitrogen from worm urine = 4,306 pounds per acre.**

***Worm drainage = equivalent of 162 miles of 6-inch tile placed on 5-foot centers over the entire farm.**
