



The problems that Portal technology addresses

- Too much irrelevant information
- Relevant data exists, but it's hidden in numerous systems
- Difficult to integrate various applications and data sources into one user experience
- Too many user ID / passwords difficult to remember and maintain
- Difficult to collaborate with other employees in remote sites or business partners around the world
- Need to provide an e-business experience to customers, partners, and employees
- Available solutions are too expensive for small and medium business

Portal - Single Point of Personalized Interaction with Applications, Content, Processes and People



- Minimum hardware requirements
 - iSeries Model 810 with processor feature 2465



Installation Best Practices – Lessons Learned


 Perform detailed pre-install planning to identify the topology and the required components

- ✓ Make sure you meet all the pre-requisites
- ✓ Read Information Center and Release Notes carefully
- ✓ Size your hardware with WLE
- ✓ Install only the required set of components
- ✓ Allocate more than few hours to complete the installation
- ✓ Install a test environment on a separate LPAR partition
- ✓ Lastly, follow the setup instructions to the word, all steps






Configuration - Internal ports used by the Application Server






