About PTF U809897

PTF U809897, also referred to as Service Pack 3, for Infoprint Transform Manager for Linux, Version 1.2.3, includes:

- Support for PDF 1.6 and below.
- Enhanced problem determination.
- DSC compliant PostScript parallel page processing.
- Support for the Infoprint Transform Manager DBCS Font Downloader.
- Support for the Infoprint Transform Manager for Linux: afp2pdf Transform i-listed PRPQ, Program Number 5799-TWL.

Updating Transform Manager from the IBM Web site

When a Service Pack is made available for Transform Manager, you need to determine the FTP Web site where the Service Pack is available for downloading.

These Service Packs are available for Transform Manager:

- Service Pack 1, also called PTF U806504, is located at <http://www-1.ibm.com/support/docview.wss?uid=psd1P4000470>
- Service Pack 2, also called PTF U809395, is located at <http://www-1.ibm.com/support/docview.wss?uid=psd1P4000495>
- Service Pack 3, also called PTF U809897, is located at <http://www-1.ibm.com/support/docview.wss?uid=psd1P4000516>

Note: You can not install a Service Pack unless you have already installed the base code for Transform Manager.

To update Transform Manager with a Service Pack from one of the IBM Web Sites, also called a PTF or SP, complete these steps:

1. Access the appropriate Web Site. The appropriate download page opens. For example, Infoprint Transform Manager for Linux PTF U806504.
2. Follow the download instructions on the page for the format of the Transform Manager server and the Transform Manager blade code.

Uninstalling PTF U809897

Use this procedure to uninstall PTF U809897, which is also called Service Pack 3.

1. Open your Linux start menu.
2. Select **Uninstall Transform Manager Service Pack 3**. You see the Welcome to the uninstall program screen.
3. Click **Next**. You see the Summary Screen stating that the InstallShield Wizard has successfully uninstalled Transform Manager Service Pack 3.
4. Click **Uninstall**. You see the screen stating that Transform Manager Service Pack 3 has successfully uninstalled.
5. Click **Finish** to exit the wizard.
