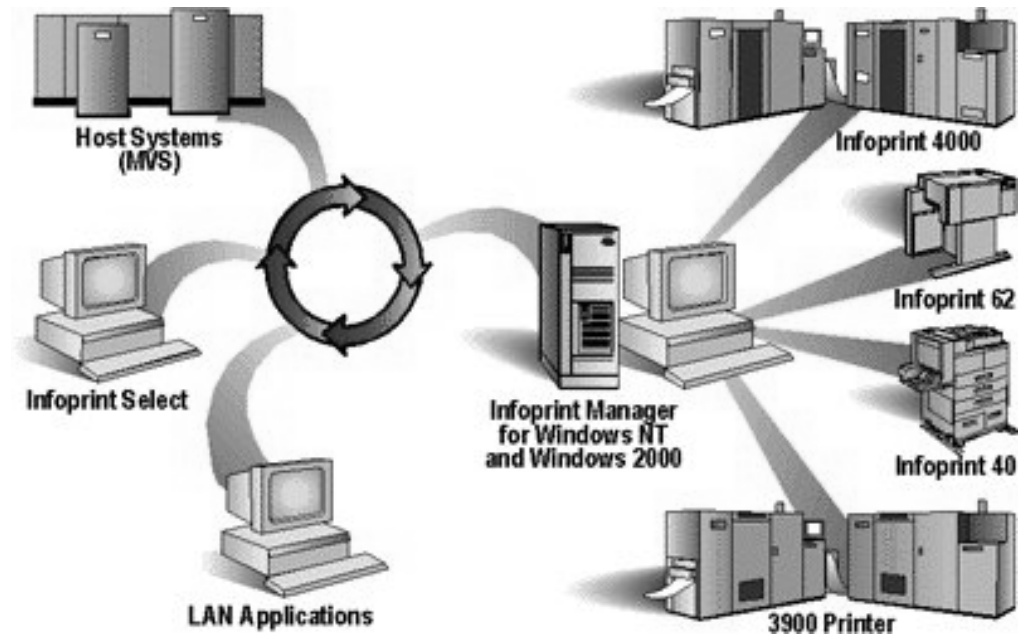


Submitting and Managing Jobs with Infoprint Manager for Windows NT and Windows 2000

Submitting Infoprint Jobs

Infoprint Manager for Windows NT and Windows 2000 supports a range of applications to support your particular job submission needs. You can install the Infoprint Manager **Infoprint Select** clients to support application printing from your Windows and OS/2 work stations. You can also use the Infoprint Manager Windows gateway printer for printing from applications.

You can use the **lpr** or **pdpr** print submission commands from a command line to submit print jobs. The **pdpr** command is part of the Infoprint Select remote client installation and is automatically installed on your Windows NTserver. The **lpr** command is supported by work stations as well and requires no additional installation.

Managing Jobs and Printers--Operator tasks

You can use the Infoprint Manager Operations GUI or Infoprint Manager commands to perform a wide range of printer operator tasks. From the server or from remote work stations, operators can use this interface to monitor the status of all jobs and printers in the system and to route jobs appropriately to increase enterprise wide printing productivity.

Managing Jobs and Printers--Administrator tasks

Print Administration tasks can be performed from two Infoprint Manager GUIs. The print administrator responsible for creating print destinations and configuring the routes to those destinations will use either the Management Console or the Infoprint Manager Administration GUI.

Use the Management Console to create PSF Direct actual destinations if you're only going to use them for PSF printing Destinations used for LAN and PSF printing should be created from the Infoprint Manager Administration GUI.
