You can access IBM Directory Manager (on the desktop) to modify LDAP. First do a "Rebind" with "cn=root"/"password".

The best way to add a user is to select a user and "Duplicate" it. Then change the key info. Be thorough.

Log on as georgep/password. This ID is enrolled in most of the courses deployed - including 2 NETg courses.

To start:

- 1. Click on Services icon in the top Taskbar (Looks like gears)
- 2. Find IBM Tivoli Directory Server, select, right click, start
- 3. Click on Start LMS in the top Taskbar.
- 4. When "Pause" appears, you are ready to go.
- 5. Click on the "Launch Internet Explorer"
  - The link bar has links to LMS and WAS Admin

If you need to add users to LDAP, use the IBM Tivoli Directory Configuration tool. Stop the server and import an Idif. There is a sample: c:\updateLDAP.Idif that you could use as a template.
