# WEB ANALYSIS 11.1.1 FOR IBM I INSTALLATION QUICK START

### **SERVER REQUIREMENTS**

- Windows 2003 SP1 (R2 is also supported) or
  - Windows 2003 SP1, Server Enterprise x64 Edition (R2 is also supported)
- 1 GB disk space minimum
- 1 GB RAM minimum
- DVD-ROM drive required for installation if you use physical media to install your release.
- Database repository using a supported RDBMS (see Oracle's "<u>Installation Start Here</u>" document for specific requirements)

The following third-party software is also required:

- NetWeaver BI and SAP BW 7.0 connectivity require the use of SAP JCO 2.1.7. For Microsoft SQL Server, you need Microsoft SQL Server (2005 or 2000 SP3a) Analysis Services. The SSAS client and SSAS server versions must match.
- SQL Grid connectivity (supports SQL Grid with Oracle Database, IBM DB2, and Microsoft SQL Server)— Merant drivers
- An X virtual frame buffer (X11/Xvfb) or a hardware graphics display device \*
  - \* Oracle recommends that an X virtual frame buffer (Xvfb) be used instead of a hardware graphics display device (because Xvfb performs all operations in memory and does not require that a screen or input device be attached to the computer).

## **CLIENT REQUIREMENTS**

- Windows Vista (except Home edition), Windows XP Professional SP2, or Windows Server 2003 SP1 (R2 also supported)
- x86-32 processor, 1.6 GHz or higher (Windows 2003 SP1 also supports x86-64)
- 1 GB RAM recommended for all clients
- EPM system installer: 8 GB disk space (After installation, these files and assemblies can be removed.)
- DVD-ROM required for installation if you use physical media to install your release.
- MS Internet Explorer 6.0–7.0.x or Mozilla Firefox 2.0.x
- Java Runtime Environment 1.5.0 Update 12

## JAVA™ PLUG-IN

To use the Web Analysis Java Web Client and Web Analysis Administration Tools, you need Java Plug-in 1.5.0 12 or later.

If you do not have the plug-in installed, you will be prompted to install it when you launch one of the Web Analysis applications. It may take several minutes to load the plug-in.

**Note:** You must have administrative authority to your PC to install the plug-in.

#### TO INSTALL WEB ANALYSIS FOR IBM i

For complete installation instructions, see Chapter 5 in the *Essbase for IBM i Installation Guide*.

- 1. Insert the DVD into the DVD-ROM drive.
- **2.** Copy all zip files from the \Windows folder on the DVD to a temporary folder on your PC.
- **3.** Unzip all zip files into the same temporary folder, clicking Yes if you are prompted to overwrite files.
- **4.** Double-click *InstallTool.cmd* to start the installer.
