- Integration Enabling people and systems to work together

Business Integration

- Enables disparate people and computing resources inside and outside the enterprise to work together to support the company's business strategy.
- Breaks down traditional barriers between applications, internal departments and external organisations, leading to greater efficiency, improved business control and enhanced flexibility.






Why is integration so important to business ?

Unifying your information for a single "view of truth" Information Connectivity

- Create a single view of information, and then make it available where and when it's needed
 - Standardize and route claim, referral and enrollment data submitted in accordance with the HIPPA federal regulations - enabling business engineers and application developers to view blueprints/models to update specifications from a unified location
- Ensure there's only one version of key business information that every part of the business can work on


Optimizing business processes through automation Process Integration







Business Integration - the technical challenges




Business Integration WEBSPHERE Application Server



messaging backbone 35 platforms




Business Integration - CROSSWORLDS



Business Integration with WEBSPHERE MQ integrator


Business process modeling/monitoring HOLOSOFX/MQWorkflow)




Publish and Subscribe - puts you in control of events

Benefit:

- Allows applications/ users to be specific about the information they need (subject level or content)
- ~ Enables agility by ability to quickly specify in real time changes of subject and content interest
- Reduces unwanted information on the network or through your door

Uses (limitless)

"Tell me when a pressure valve "A" on a remote pipe line in the desert reaches a 1000s of concurrent clients particular level and then automatically open "B" and "C"
"Alert me if stock prices for company X reaches \$XXX per share"
"Let me have all results for a sporting event between for the next three hours"
"Shut down all appliances if the electricity usage exceeds X units between hours of 2am and 6am."






MQSeries Workflow and HOLOSOFX - Integrates and Manages your Business Processes

WebSphere Partner Agreement Manager-Business to Business Integration

- Process Firewall






Widening your Horizons beyond Traditional BtoB






IBM Web Services - extending and integrating your services WW





Wouldn't it be good if you...

- ...didn't need to source connectors/adapters for packaged app's?
 - Web Services standards are defining an open way for app vendors to expose integration interfaces
- ...could find resources easily?
 - ► Web Services implementations are providing infrastructure to describe and discover services
- ...could work from IT to business levels and across functions with one set of metadata and process information?
 - Eclipse provides an extensible tooling framework, common model for metadata and process
 - Unified programming model describes low-level app logic up to high-level business flows in a common way
- ...could create new business logic from existing services?
 - Web Services standards are evolving to provide descriptions of the way that services are coordinated to deliver business function
- ...could modify and extend existing business logic within app's?
 - Applications built on the web services standards will allow functions to be replaced, shared and augmented
