







Up position

Notes Browser Plug-in


- Designed to easily extend applications previously available only to Notes users out to web browser users, as well
- Provides a powerful compliment to existing XPages capabilities
- Allows application: to run in a browser with no modification!
- Lightweight install, lar to other plug-ins in size, deployment time and configuration requiren
- Minimal limitations:
 - Windows only (for now, at least!)
 - Not designed to support mail templa
 - Firefox and Internet Explorer along with
- Licensing plans: Enterprise

- Supports standard ActiveSync direct connection to Traveler
- When BB10 is connected directly to Exchange ActiveSync (no BDS):
- Managed by Exchange ActiveSync Policies/IT Commands
- Exchange ActiveSync data sits in the Personal Perimeter
- To enable device encryption for local storage set require password and prohibit unencrypted devices on Traveler




