This offering provides a production-level, Windows-based document capture application. Included in the capabilities are scanning, OCR, document indexing, and storage management. The use of common indexes, enables users to dynamically search, retrieve and view, multiple document types from Content Manager OnDemand. This offering provides the integration of Kofax Ascent Capture software, with industry standard document scanners to automate document scanning, indexing and archive storage in Content Manager OnDemand.

From the browser, the user can request to view a stored AFP document, and as it is retrieved from the archive have it dynamically transformed, via the AFP2WEB transform, to either Dynamic HTML or PDF.
