What is OfficeVision/400?



1. Calendar

• (Diary). Events, reminders, meetings, multiple view, free time search. Remote support. Job scheduling.

2, 3, 4. EMail

 Messages, notes, documents, PC files, confirmation of delivery, action due, etc. Interface to AnyMail for SMTP addressing. Integration with fax.

5. Document Library (document profile)

• File documents, PC files, hard copy reference, faxes, etc. Folder structure. Open to PCs. Index external and/or text content. Search.

What is OV/400? contd.



6. Word Processing (document content)

 Fast, high function, batch format and print, graphical interface, poor font support, PC editor option.

7. Directory

 List of people, description, name, EMail address, phone, fax, location, organisation, department, reports to, etc. plus search.

8. Database & Data/Text Merge

 High performance merge of database or Query data with text. Conditional, data-driven output.

9. Administration, Security and User Function

Enrollment profiles, authority to calendars, email, documents, etc.
 Document conversion tools.

What is JustMail/400?



Subset of OfficeVision/400

- Mail
- Directory

Note: In this presentation, please assume that references to OfficeVision/400 also include JustMail/400 for these functions.

Withdrawal of IBM Support



The Timescales

- End of Support was May 2001
- V5R1 Deletes OV/400
- '... there are changes in OS/400 V5R1 that cause the products to be incompatible. During the upgrade to V5R1 the OfficeVision product is deleted from the system; however, your data is not deleted. Prior to the upgrade, you should delete the enrollments for your OfficeVision users and delete all mail, calendars, documents, and folders that you no longer need, unless you plan to use replacement products to access that data. Users who reinstall OfficeVision on V5R1 should not expect it to run correctly.'
 - OS/400 V5R1 Memo to Users

What Exactly Happens?

- No OV/400 function remains
- Some OS/400 function is affected

IBM Plans



Strategy is Lotus Notes & Domino

- Clear message, no serious alternatives.

What will Happen to Applications?



It Depends on the degree of OV/400 integration

- Functions using OV/400 APIs will give errors
- Functions using some OS/400 APIs may give errors or unpredictable output
- Some of the changes may not be obvious, e.g. print format.

CL Commands, APIs and User Exits



Introduction

• The many APIs, commands and user exits provided by OV/400 allow for easy integration with other AS/400 products and line of business applications. End users can work entirely from OV/400 panels or OV/400 can be masked and end users can work entirely from their primary line of business application. This has resulted in OV/400 being integrated in thousands of applications.

CL Commands, APIs and User Exits

- The term API is used to refer to any application programming interface. However, in OV/400 terms we must separately consider:
 - -CL commands
 - APIs and
 - User Exits.
- The next three foils aim to explain the differences.

OV/400 CL Commands



14

The OV/400 commands are like other AS/400 Control Language (CL) commands and can be used stand-alone as well as in CL programs. They are designed to provide the link between applications, database files, programs and OfficeVision/400 objects such as directories, distribution lists and document library objects. The OfficeVision/400 and related CL Commands are listed in the Redbook

OV/400 APIs



- Application Programming Interfaces are programs that belong to the user domain but may operate in the system state. They are directly callable from high-level language programs. They allow you to:
 - ► Use system information and functions that are not available through CL commands.
 - ► Provide better performance when getting system information or when using system functions that are provided by CL commands.
 - ► Use calls from high-level languages to those interfaces.
- There are a dozen or so OfficeVision/400 APIs. Their use is largely restricted to:
 - ► 1. OfficeVision/400 application enabler
 - ► 2. Optimising performance when calling an OfficeVision/400 function
 - ► 3. Displaying calendar information in an OfficeVision/400 session
 - After the withdrawal of OfficeVision/400, only the application enabler APIs (at an OS/400 V2R2 level) will be available.

OV/400 Exit Programs



- An exit program is a specific point in an IBM software product where a
 user program or application can be invoked by the IBM software product
 upon some condition. User exits are provided to modify or extend the
 functions of an IBM software product with which an application program is
 running, where the modification or extension affects only that particular
 application.
- There are half a dozen OfficeVision/400 user exit programs. As they are called from an OfficeVision/400 user session they will not be appropriate in future. They are used in two main areas:
 - ◆ Application enabler
 - ► Replaced in a Domino environment by IBM BNDW for AS/400 (BlueNotes Document Warehouse).
 - Directory search
 - ► Part of OS/400 and is still available through CL commands when called from other applications.

OS/400 CL Commands



Many 'OV/400' commands are in fact 'OS/400' and will remain

e.g. SAVDLO, SNDDST, CRTFLR

Much 'OV/400' function is in fact OS/400 and will remain

• e.g. Shared Folders, Directory

Some OS/400 commands use OV/400 function

- e.g. PRTDOC
- Their function will be reduced or command will fail
- Most can be directed to call other applications

 - recent document edits, future calendar entries, scheduled jobs, Facsimile Support integration

Do I have OV/400 Data?

- See Redbook for:
 - Counting documents and folders, counting EMail items, counting Calendars and entries

Am I Using OfficeVision/400? (continued)



Are OV/400 APIs In Use?

- See Redbook for audit information
 - journalling API usage
 - scanning source

Do My Own Applications Contain OV/400 APIs?

- Ask the developer
- See Redbook for audit information

Do my documents contain data/text merge instructions?

Inventive Designer tool (I-D Web site)

Do Third Party Applications Contain OV/400 APIs?

- Ask the software house
- See Redbook for audit information

Development Guidelines



How to Use The Redbook

- Determine the OV/400 functions to be replaced
- Review the matching Redbook section
- Select products and study in detail

Development Strategies

- Quick fix or major rewrite, or fix then rewrite?
- What clients? 5250? GUI? Notes? Web?
- Future of 5250 datastream
 - no longer strategic
 - no longer tied to SNA or twinax
 - clear cost penalties in hardware (still) and in Client Access/400

Development Guidelines, contd.



Notes/Domino Development Techniques

- @ functions. LotusScript, JavaScript, Java
- DECS, Lotus Enterprise Integrator, APIs (separate Redbook)

Client-Server Development Techniques

CA/400 Solution Developer Kit for ActiveX and OLE DB

Enabling OS/400 Commands

Tell OS/400 to use non-OV/400 or no other function, e.g. CRTDOC

Shared Folders vs. /root of IFS.

- Better performance in IFS, but no document profile
- Perhaps too early to exploit some tools not ready
- Use shared folders for now

Guidelines, contd.



OV/400 Database Files

- API's protected from underlying changes. Unlikely to change now.
- Use directly or use as basis for redesign

Testing

- Try new editors for fidelity of conversion
- BlueNotes demo for sample complex OV/400 documents
- Migrate users to Notes first

OV/400 Data Cleanup

- Delete OV/400 data before deleting OV/400 program
 - the housekeeping commands are part of OV/400
- Delete selected OV/400 program components and test
- Keep the manuals

Are Notes and Domino the Answer?



Usually, but not always

- e.g. OS/400 or Job Scheduler for jobs
- AFP for data/text merge with bar codes

Most function is available in Notes/Domino R5

email, calendars, directory, etc.

Other function is accessible from Notes/Domino

document library

Lots more function too

workflow, Web, etc

A few gaps in the Notes/Domino picture

- external documents, WP editor, query/text merge
- filled by IBM and 3rd party products

Third Party Approaches

- PC-based editors, e.g. MS Word
 - Check for filters.
- DTM for AS/400 from Inventive Designers
 - data merge tool has WP function

Used For

 Creating and labelling Help Text with OV/400 editor. OS/400 DSPHLPDOC API to display by document or label.

Effect of Withdrawal

No update text editor which also retains labels

Notes/Domino Approach

Split labelled text to smaller documents (enables display without labels).
 Later cut and paste to Notes RTF.

IBM AFP

Recreate with AFP 'labels'. View from AFP Viewer.

Lotus WordPro Approach

Edit text but lose labels

Data/Text Merge



Used For

- Standard letters, address labels, reports
 - merging DB2/400 data or Queries with standard text, usually to print

Effect of Withdrawal

No function

Notes/Domino Approach

- IBM BNDM for AS/400
 - BlueNotes Direct Messaging (was Data Merge)
 - Notes & Domino-based form letters, reports and statements
 - User and Developer options
 - ► Notes Rich Text Format, AFP support
 - Output to Notes documents (opt. reuse in Notes & Web applications)
 - Unified Messaging one merge to print/email/fax/Web
 - Appropriate for Domino customers
 - See Triangle Connectors for RPG/CL Domino integration

Data/Text Merge, continued



IBM RPG & Advanced Function Printing

- Range of tools
 - AFP Utilities/400 Print Format Utility
 - AFP Toolbox
 - Data Description Specifications
- Appropriate for address labels and fixed format letters
 - Full AFP function including bar codes, logos, overlays
 - limited text manipulation, no word wrap

Lotus SmartSuite

- Client/server environment
 - -ODBC connection to DB2/400, e.g. Client Access/400
 - Letters and labels with Lotus WordPro
 - Reports with Lotus Approach
- Appropriate for end user access and low volumes
 - easy to use

IBM Network Stations



Introduction

 Many customers with Non-Programmable Terminals will not want to move to a fully configured PC and Notes. The IBM Network Station may be a suitable alternative.

Network Station Options

- 5250 Emulation to OV/400 or EverGreen/400
- Web browser to Domino plus a suite:
- a) Lotus eSuite
 - Java-based word processing, email, calendar, spreadsheet, etc (a mini suite)
 - N.B. No current support in editor for RFT and FFT documents
 - No future development. Withdrawn from marketing.
- OpenOffice suite (was StarOffice) for WP, spreadsheet and presentation.
 Run under Linux in OS/400 logical partition with X-Windows client on PC or NetworkStation.

System/36 & System/38 Applications



Introduction

 Not everyone has got to OV/400 yet. System/36 and /38 run the predecessor products. Migration to Notes is usually via OV/400.

System/36

- DisplayWrite/36 and Personal Services/36
- Migration Tools to OV/400
- Save/restore folder options

System/38

- Text Management/38 and Personal Services/38
- Migration Tools to OV/400
