This guide gets you started with a typical installation for IBM InfoSphere Classification Module.



Product overview

By analyzing content and applying rules, IBM® InfoSphere™ Classification Module automates decision making for a wide range of applications that require unstructured content to be categorized. IBM InfoSphere Classification Module provides integration with IBM FileNet® P8, IBM Content Manager, and IBM Content Collector, enabling advanced classification for content collection and archiving, records management, legal discovery, and other enterprise content management applications.

1 Step 1: Access your software and documentation

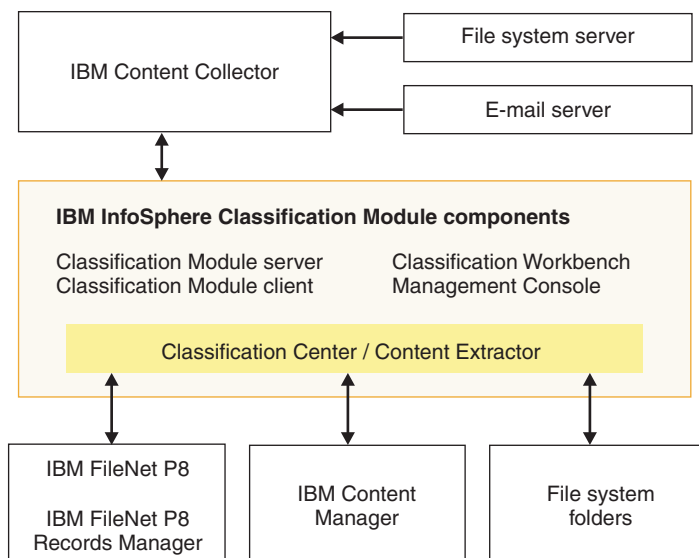
2 Step 2: Evaluate your hardware and system configuration

3 Step 3: Review the base architecture

You can run IBM InfoSphere Classification Module as a stand-alone product or use the Classification Center and Content Extractor applications to classify content that is stored in IBM FileNet P8, IBM Content Manager, and file system repositories. A Classification Module system can also help IBM Content Collector determine how to process documents and e-mail by analyzing content and metadata when items enter the system.



4 Step 4: Install IBM InfoSphere Classification Module

To install the software, run the appropriate installation program for your environment:

- AIX®: `./icmsetup87_aix.bin`
- Linux®: `./icmsetup87_linux.bin`
- Solaris: `./icmsetup87_sunos.bin`
- Windows®: `icmsetup87_win32.exe`

5 Step 5: Set up classification for your repository



IBM InfoSphere Classification Module provides automatic classification services for IBM FileNet P8, IBM Content Manager, and file systems. The requirements and set up procedures are different for each repository type.
