### **Enhancements**

### **Auction charts**

Users can now use the following features for viewing data as charts:

- The Summary tab of the Monitor page now has the following new fields:
  - Date Range From To specify the date and time from which users want to see the bids.
  - Date Range To To specify the date and time till which users want to see the bids
  - Include Preliminary Bids check box To include preliminary bids from the chart view.
- The date feature helps to view the chart clearly if the event contains a lot of data points on the chart at a position.
- Preliminary bids can now be plotted on the date and time the bids are entered.
- Users can now view bids across different rounds at the same time.

# **Offline Bid Template**

The offline bid template now has a new option of 'No Bid' in the Action column. Users can select this option when they do not want to bid for an item. The value in the Action column determines if bid for an item can be imported or not.

Users can now import items in the following conditions:

- When Price Per Unit is hidden, One Time Charge does not have a value, and other bid fields have a value.
- When Price Per Unit is made as formula and participating bid fields are left blank.
- When Price Per Unit has a default value, the items no longer get imported with default value, when no bid option is used.

### **Export**

The Export button is now made configurable and is available on the Summary tab. The epass.allow.locked.rfx.export=true flag controls the visibility of the export

button on the Summary page and the export of event from the List and Portal page. The default value is **true**.

When the flag is set to **true** the button is available on the Summary page and events can be exported.

When the flag is set to false the button is not visible and the event cannot be exported.

### **Export All**

The application properties file can now be configured to restrict the availability of the **Export All** functionality to certain user roles only.

### **Locked Events**

The application properties file can now be configured to restrict the following options for Locked Events:

epass.bids.notification.lockedevents.visibility=

Set to **true**, to completely restrict buyers from receiving notifications from suppliers. Set to **false**, to restrict buyers from receiving bid information in the bid submitted notification.

• epass.rfx.locked. include.message.attachment=

Set to **true**, to restrict buyers from receiving messages containing attachments from suppliers. They receive attachments if the value is set to **false**.

• epass.show locked events rfxsummary report=

Set to **false** to restrict locked events from appearing in the RFx Summary report and Search result window when using search.

### **Notifications**

The application properties file can now be configured to set the sender details for Buyer Survey. The options you can use are the primary contact for the Buyer Survey, or the System Default user account.

### **Sourcing Desktop Intelligence**

When you generate a Ranking report, you can now select a value of up to 500 ranks from the **Rank up to** field in Sourcing Desktop Intelligence.

### Search

- Buyers can now search messages that are sent and received for a particular supplier organization from the Search Message page. The Supplier Name field is added in the Search Message page to enhance the search capability of messages.
- Buyers can search with the wild character asterisk (\*) from the top right corner of the application.

# **Changes to OJEU Notices**

When you select an option between 17 to 27 from the Service Category (Services) drop-down list, it is now mandatory to select Yes or No in the Services 17-27 (Agreement for publication) field in Section II of the Contract Award Notice.

The Emptoris Sourcing application now uses the following database servers:

# **Application Server**

The Emptoris Sourcing application now uses the IBM WebSphere® Application Server Standard Edition 8.0.0.3 (64-bit) instead of the JBOSS application server.

# **Browser Support**

The Sourcing application now also supports Mozilla Firefox 12 and Google Chrome 18 browsers.

# **Notifications**

#### **Regret Notification**

Buyer users now have an option of sending a regret letter to suppliers who have not been awarded business.

#### Recipient selection

While creating a new message, you can now select the recipients to whom you want to send the message through the select box. You can also view the list of the selected recipients.

# **Copy RFx Items**

You can now make copies of items for bidding in RFPs, RFQs, and all types of auctions. The copy items feature is helpful when you have to create multiple items with similar configurations.

# **Suite Integration**

### **Lines of Contracts**

Contracts when created in Emptoris Contracts Management from an event in Emptoris Sourcing, can now have a large number of lines with item and bid details.

## **IF Template Limitations**

#### The following limitations exist for IF templates:

- Users cannot export large number of events (more than 200 events) in XML in a single operation.
- When an RFx that contains a Decimal type of field is exported and a value that
  contains more than the allowed number of digits after the decimal point is entered,
  the value is accepted but it cannot be imported back.

**Workaround:** Use the information in the comment provided for the field to enter the correct number of digits for this field before you import it.

Please use the following suggestions:

- Unfreeze panes If the comment appears at the top of the window or worksheet and the bottom or right half of the comment is cut off, you may have frozen panes. To view the entire comment, on the Window menu, click Unfreeze Panes.
- Enlarge the comment box Right-click the cell that contains the comment, click Edit Comment on the shortcut menu, and then drag the handles until you can see all of the comment text.

### **Currency Administration**

Procedure of Currency Conversions When Exchange Rate Information is Missing

Pulling Catalog Data (Historical Pricing) into an RFx When Exchange Rate Information is Missing

The system uses an implicit exchange rate of 1 to convert the organization/system primary currency value for the product into the RFx currency value in the following situations:

- the currency table does not exist.
- there is no current currency table.
- the currency table exists but the necessary exchange rate has not been defined.

Pushing RFx Data (Award Data) into the Catalog When Exchange Rate Information is Missing (Note: This applies only to organizations with SourceLink enabled.)

The system uses an implicit exchange rate of 1 to convert the RFx currency value for an item to the organization/system primary currency value if the following information is missing:

- the currency table does not exist.
- there is no current currency table.
- the currency table exists but the necessary exchange rate has not been defined.

Reports use an Implicit Rate of 1.00 when Exchange Rate Information is missing.

## Import/Export

#### Settings for Sourcing Desktop Intelligence Report

- To run Sourcing Desktop Intelligence, the security setting in MS Excel must be set to Medium (recommended) or Low.
- Enable Macros if you set the security setting to Medium.
- The user guide for Sourcing Desktop Intelligence is available only in English.

#### Considerations for RFP reports using the crosstab option (For Excel 2003 only)

When running RFP reports using the crosstab option, users can select a large number of suppliers and run the report in the .XLS format. The report is generated successfully but it may not open in MS Excel 2003.

**Reason:** MS Excel 2003 supports 256 columns and if the report contains more than 256 columns it cannot be opened in MS Excel 2003.

#### Workaround:

• Reduce the number of suppliers for the report.

- Select only the required score-types, either raw or weighted.
- Do not include the question/questionnaire details option.
- Include the My Score option.
- Run the report by supplier, questionnaire, or item instead of crosstabs. Suppliers are displayed as rows in these options.

#### Offline Bidding template

When users place bids in an offline bidding template that is downloaded from a version prior to 9.0.3, and uses this template to import the bids and responses in 9.5.0.1, then though the import job is displayed as 'Done', the responses and bids do not get imported.

Work around:

Users must download the offline bid template from 9.5.0.1 version and place bids.

#### **RFx**

#### **Manual Invitation Limitation**

When an RFx, which has manual invitations enabled, is set to Pending Invitation status for subsequent rounds, the RFx is no longer visible to the included supplier until the RFx is set to Pending or Open.

#### **Precaution While Entering URL**

Importing an RFx or Line Item attribute with an invalid URL or creating a Text\_Single attribute field with an invalid URL does not result in a failure. It is not possible for the system to validate the URL format completely.

Workaround: Verify that a URL is valid before entering it.

#### Approach for Rounding Bids

System generated bids such as Proxy Bids and bids created by the Take Lead feature use a rounding mechanism based on auction type. To calculate the effective PPU, a Forward Auction rounds up the Ceiling Price and Reverse Auction rounds down the Floor Price. If the PPU equals 1.66666666, for example, then depending on the type of auction, Emptoris Sourcing does the following:

- Forward Auction Ceiling Price is rounded up to 1.67.
- Reverse Auction Floor Price is rounded down to 1.66.

**Note:** When the Minimum Bid Change feature generates a bid, the bid is always rounded up. In the above example, a PPU of 1.66666666 generated with the Minimum Bid Change feature is rounded up to 1.67 for a Reverse Auction.
