FileNet Content Manager offers IBM FileNet Content Federation Services (CFS) that allows for content in CS and IBM FileNet Images Services (IS) to be managed by FileNet Content Manager while these existing systems remain in production. Content Services and Image Services content can now be a full participant in FileNet P8 process management initiatives without requiring conversion or migration.

FileNet Content Manager provides extensive support for content federation across an enterprise as well as providing integration capabilities to content enabled by third-party systems such as CRM solutions. Content Manager's integration capabilities are segmented as follows:
