Overview

IBM FileNet Connector for Microsoft
Visio allows customers to gain
immediate return on their investment by
importing existing Microsoft Visio
diagrams into IBM FileNet Process
Designer, providing a Microsoft Visio
BPMN stencil and template, and
facilitating process automation in IBM
FileNet Business Process Manager.

Today's dynamic global economy requires organizations to effectively utilize resources and implement agile processes. Defining and modeling key business processes build the necessary foundation to understand and improve operational efficiency. Furthermore, they provide a logical entry point for process automation implementations, where efficiency gains can deliver significant cost savings and real competitive advantages.

Most companies define, document and design vital business processes using Microsoft's ubiquitous desktop applications, such as Microsoft Visio. How to take these documented processes from process maps to production is a challenge to many organizations since it involves new technology adoption and collaboration between various departments and users. Therefore, allowing business users to continue modeling workflows in a familiar environment or even reusing workflow diagrams from Microsoft Visio would introduce substantial time, resource and cost savings.

IBM FileNet Connector for Microsoft Visio accelerates process automation and implementation by allowing customers to leverage investments in Microsoft Visio and to import legacy workflow diagrams into IBM FileNet

Process Designer for process deployment and execution, including process simulation capabilities. Additional standards-based tools enable business users to continue using Visio as the primary process design tool while providing precise mapping accuracy when importing into Process Designer. Lastly, this functionality bridges the gap between business process design and process implementation by facilitating communication of complete business processes between business and technical users.

Features & Benefits Intuitive Import Wizard

Enables import of Microsoft Visio workflow diagrams into IBM FileNet Process Designer in seven simple steps. An intuitive Wizard guides users through the process step-bystep, validates import shapes and texts against more than 300 premapped objects, and provides a summary report. Users can also customize and save unique object mappings during the import process for future reuse.

BPMN Template and Stencil

Provides Business Process Modeling Notation (BPMN) template and stencil for use in Microsoft Visio. Developed to industry specification by IBM, these BPMN resources



provide standards-based design shapes for process modeling to promote consistency across the enterprise and to increase mapping accuracy during the import process from Visio to Process Designer.

Workflow Collections

Supports import of multiple process diagrams and related subprocesses one at a time or in groups. Workflow collections allow users, such as business analysts and departmental workflow authors, to keep related, complex processes together for better collaboration.

Annotations Support

Imports and maintains descriptive texts on process modeling diagrams from the native Microsoft Visio environment to Process Designer. Specific instructions, exceptions, and other important user notations remain as part of the process map to keep every detail intact throughout multiple project hand-offs. Users have the additional flexibility to show or hide annotations, and to use different colors for annotations in Process Designer.
