## E64 The Nuts and Bolts of IMS Connect

This in-depth level session provides insight on the structure of IMS Connect. It addresses specific details related to IMS Connect Functions, Configuration File Parms, Asynch Output, Socket types, User Message Exits, Data Translation, User Init Exit, DRU exit, Conversation, Commit Modes, and Synch Level. Changes to the IRM, RSM, CSM and OTMA headers structures are also discussed. Other topics include the installation of IMS Connect, with directions on user installation of IMS Connect's, Message Exits (three), the User Init Exit, and the IMS DRU exit.

This session is aimed at those customers who have IMS TOC or IMS Connect installed and in production or is currently into testing. A helpful prerequisite for this session is E63, An Introduction to IMS Connect.
