

E66 Technology to Access Your IMS Databases

Where is your data? It's in IMS and IMS continues to evolve and provide new technology to open access to your IMS data. This presentation describes how Open Database Access (ODBA) can be used to access IMS DB databases from a variety of OS/390 application execution environments. When the application has completed IMS database change processing it needs a syncpoint manager to provide two-phase commit processing. OS/390 Resource Recovery Services (RRS) is a syncpoint manager. This presentation discusses how RRS is used to perform the two-phases commit processing. In this presentation, you will also learn how to establish ODBA connectivity to IMS DB and how to build an application to access IMS DB via ODBA.
