E94 Swest's Solution to Providing Consistent Databases in a 7x24 Environment

Swest is a service center in the western part of Germany that supports 86 savings banks and the WestLB, the largest public bank in Germany. The business volume of these banks is about \$600 billion. There are several interconnected production systems that provides support for 55,000 active workstations and the IMS subsystems perform 1000 to 1500 transactions per second. This session describes Swest's solution to provide 'consistent' reports of databases which are updated 24 hours a day. Time event driven reports at any chosen timestamp are possible as well as updates in the future. For example, updating data in all database records to change the value of interest rates from 5% to 4% to take effect 01/01/2001. Come hear about this high availability solution and the benefits Swest gained from this implementation!
