Business Challenge

Health and Human Services (HHS) agencies have a tremendous responsibility to protect and ensure childrens' welfare. To support this critical work, they need accessible and robust reporting systems that allow administrators, managers and staff to track and report process and performance status and outcomes in real time. However, many agencies struggle with the absence of centralized and integrated information repositories, which make it difficult to retrieve data on a real-time basis and to facilitate collaboration and process optimization.
