
CENTER (RFIDIC) is a standards-based data repository and data sharing platform for serialized product movement information.
RFIDIC allows companies to extend insights and visibility into product movement with trusted trading partners. RFIDIC is IBM's implementation of the EPCglobal Electronic Product Code Information Services (EPCIS) 1.0 specification, which is a standard that defines interfaces for data capture and data query. This product allows

customers to maintain large amounts of serialized data captured from RFID or 2D/1D barcodes, generate reports based on the data and share that data securely with trading partners.

EVENT data maintained in the event repository can be used to generate electronic pedigree for state, federal and global regulations and can also be used to solve additional businessuse cases such as inventory management and diversion tracking, product authentication and reverse logistics.



WEBSPHERE RFID Information Center ePedigree Feature leverages EPCIS events and services to represent and exchange serialized pedigree information with directly linked trading partners.




