Implementation Background

- Company Overview
 - Agriculture
 - 8 operating divisions
 - Produce from seed to fork
 - 28 reporting entities
 - Oracle based ERP system
- Reporting requirements
 - Consolidated financial statements
 - Divisional operational statements
 - Monthly Packing Report



Implementation Background

- Reporting requirements
 - Consolidated financial statements
 - Manually Run financial statements from ERP and key into excel
 - Divisional operational statements
 - Run financial statements and key into excel
 - Run production reports from ERP and key into excel
 - Calculate gross margins through a combination of production reports, financial reports and inventory level



Implementation Background

- Reporting requirements
 - Monthly Packing Report (all keyed into excel)
 - Pull data from ERP system (multiple entities)
 - Pull production information from invoicing module
 - Pull production information from packing module



Data mapping

- Table map of ERP database
- Understand where data is coming from
 - Breakdown of information from reports (know the source)
 - Map modules in ERP to the data table
 - Example differing units of measure
 - Use turbo integrator to load the data (use of tm1 consultant).
 - T.I. drives population of data



Segmenting reports

- Start with the most non-value added processes
 - Ex. Keying in information for a BS & IS
- Use data and reports that are easy to validate and extract
- Lastly work on putting advanced data and calculations in tm1.
 - Ex. Budgets, forecasts, consolidation entries.
- Continually work on automating



User Acceptance/Data Validation/Training

- Combine all three activities
- Set the tone at the top
- Set up hierarchy of information flow
 - Consultant to champion(s)
 - Champion to division leads
 - Division leads to remaining users



User Acceptance/Data Validation/Training

- Include all user levels in the development of reports
 - Have the user responsible for report validate their own data.
 - Avoid outsourcing the implementation to IT. Finance should be and can be involved from beginning to end.
- Make sure data can be isolated in ERP and Tm1



User Acceptance/Data Validation/Training

- Training
 - Involve individuals responsible for reports early and often.
 - Reporting environment is excel. If a user can function in excel then the user can write reports in Tm1.
 - Keep emphasizing the need to move in Tm1. (important for multi-stage implementation).
 - Make users convert reporting into Tm1.
 - As with everything, there is a significant initial time and effort investment.



Result of implementation

- Cut out 80 to 100 hours out of closing time
- Added additional reports that would normally take 60 to 70 hours to produce
 - Developing new reports that would take between 200 and 300 hours
- The entire finance department is using tm1.
- Payroll and sales support departments are beginning to use tm1.
- More accurate results. No version issues
