Features and benefits

Traditionally, information has been delivered to mobile workers through desktop formats such as Microsoft Excel®, Adobe® PDF and HTML. Unfortunately, these tools offer limited practicality for mobile BI as they have not been optimized to provide the required interactive experience. Microsoft Excel is difficult to scroll, PDFs offer limited interactivity and HTML can be slow or completely unusable when out of network coverage.

IBM Cognos 8 Go! Mobile overcomes these limitations by delivering a rich mobile client interface designed for business intelligence. It allows executives, leaders and mobile workers to use their handheld devices to read and interact with IBM Cognos 8 BI reports, dashboards, metrics, and other information.

This versatility makes IBM Cognos 8 Go! Mobile a logical choice for organizations with widely dispersed personnel. Executives, business analysts, sales personnel and IT staff all appreciate IBM Cognos 8 Go! Mobile because it is:

Simple – In order for new functionality to be adopted, it must be simple for users, and easy for IT to deploy and maintain. For users, IBM Cognos 8 Go! Mobile provides a familiar interface for BI, and navigation tailored to the mobile device. In terms of IT workload, it can be installed remotely on the device and has centralized administration, which means, for example, IT can quickly install or update to users without handling each device.

Complete – A complete business intelligence solution must provide a full spectrum of capabilities and consumer modes to serve all users. With the most comprehensive set of BI capabilities on the market, IBM Cognos 8 BI enables IT to meet the needs of a diverse set of users. As well, IT can add capabilities, such as IBM Cognos 8 Go! Mobile, as the need arises with the knowledge that it will fit seamlessly into their BI environment.

Secure – IBM Cognos 8 Go! Mobile is integrated with and leverages existing IBM Cognos security features to deliver a single security environment for all users regardless of how they consume reports. IBM Cognos 8 Go!

Mobile security also takes into account the unique challenges associated with mobile devices with theft/loss protection capabilities.

Feature overview

With IBM Cognos 8 Go! Mobile, organizations can put BI into the hands of the people who need it. The dedicated client interface delivers:

• Single authoring environment - BI report authors can write a report once and know that every user can access it, regardless of language, locale, or consumption approach (Web, search, mobile, desktop productivity suite, and more). The IBM Cognos 8 Go! Mobile client formats the data for the mobile device-no separate mobile authoring environment is needed-and the solution supports all reports, including prompted. This gives users access to all BI data, including new information as it is generated within the organization, rather than just a subset of arbitrary reports with limited functionality that were pre-authored in advance for mobile devices.



 Users can use IBM Cognos 8
 Go! Mobile application on their devices to navigate through reports intuitively. It leverages native mobile device functionality so they can easily see, interpret and interact (including the ability to respond to prompts on the device) with the information they need.
- Efficient data compression

 Maximizing performance on mobile devices and the network they run on is always an issue. IBM Cognos 8
 Go! Mobile compresses data before transmission and again once the report is saved on the device.

- This means users spend more time getting insight into the business rather than waiting for reports to download.

 based on their physical location at

 values pre-filled based on GPS
 coordinates.
