

Plan the project	Strategize, design and implement a IBM Cognos solution based on the available data, your specific environment, user needs, business requirements and other logistics.
Communicate to project stakeholders	Establish and foster relationships with your PMO and all relevant partners, follow up on all questions or issues, maintain constant and meaningful contact with all stakeholders, and communicate the steps in the project life cycle.
Apply proven practices	Document and apply proven practices, including the consistent use of the IBM Cognos SIM. Submit project documentation and reports on a weekly basis and at all major project milestones.
Manage the project	Assess, identify and manage project scope, priorities, risks, dependencies, and team members.
	Provide direction, coaching and mentoring to project teams.
	Manage the cost, schedule and expense control for the project.
	Effectively deploy resources and escalate issues that may impact the project.
Manage success	Deliver on project plan and resolve problems prior to escalation.
	Anticipate potential risk factors and work to mitigate these through proactive management and escalation when necessary.
Manage the project lifecycle	Analyze business requirements on an ongoing basis, define objectives and scope for new applications, identify and engage resources necessary to complete new projects, and assign tasks and deliverables to IBM Cognos staff and your PMO team.
