Announcement: CICS TS Developer Trial V4.2

Announced today, Jan 24th 2012, IBM CICS Developer Trial for z/OS V4.2 is a'try-before-you-buy' edition of CICS TS V4.2, designed for customers who want to assess the value that could be gained from a CICS TS upgrade, prior to making an upgrade decision. It will allow the evaluation of the latest CICS capabilities, in a non-production environment, before committing time and resources to a production migration project. General Availability is Friday 27th January.

CICS TS Developer Trial has a zero cost licence charge. Ordering, installing, and using CICS TS Developer Trial in a non-production environment will not initiate any Single Version Charging (SVC) period. CICS TS Developer Trial is a fully functional offering that can be used to conduct Proof of Technology (PoT) evaluations that cover the complete set of CICS TS V4.2 capabilities, but, to prevent usage in a production environment, it has a number of imposed technical and non-technical restrictions.

CICS TS Developer Trial is not formally supported, so you should use the CICSdev forum to raise any problems that you experience, see below for details.

If you want to avoid Catch-22 - you need to install CICS TS V4.2 to create a business case before you can use it, but you can't justify the installation unless you have a good business case - then CICS TS Developer Trial is just the solution you've been looking for, allowing you to determine the business value that you can derive from CICS TS V4.2 at no financial cost.
