CICS Statement of Direction

The important news item this month is today's Statement of Direction for CICS TS for z/OS, the text of which I've included in full below. This gives you important information about the future direction CICS will be taking, as well as key planning information about future support dates for CICS TS V3 and V4. In addition, there's still time to register for the *CICS Goes Mobile* webcast – so far we've had over 400 registrations, so it appears to be very interesting topic for many of you.

Product highlights

Statement of Direction - CICS Transaction Server for z/OS

IBM today issued the following statement of general direction for IBM CICS Transaction Server for z/OS:

IBM® intends to update IBM CICS® Transaction Server for z/OS® (CICS TS), to provide new application, platform, and policy capabilities that can help customers build private clouds from new and existing CICS applications. This capability is intended to assist CICS customers deploy new and updated CICS applications faster, more easily, and with greater levels of confidence.

IBM also intends to deliver new and enhanced foundation capabilities, including:

- A new lightweight Java™ web container, combining Java Servlets and JavaServer Pages (JSP) with fast local access to CICS applications.
- Increased scalability through improvements in storage and task management, and greater threadsafe coverage
- Enhanced application capability, including extended channel and container, IBM WebSphere® MQ, and Java support
- Powerful system enhancements that reduce the need for planned outages, and provide more detailed statistics about system load, capacity, and performance

In addition, to assist customers in their planning process, IBM makes the following statements of direction for IBM CICS TS for z/OS:

- IBM intends to continue to support both CICS TS V3.1 and CICS TS V3.2 until at least third quarter, 2014. This provides more than nine years of support for the overall version since its initial introduction.
- IBM intends to continue to support both CICS TS V4.1 and CICS TS V4.2 until at least third quarter, 2017. This provides more than eight years of support for the overall version since its initial introduction.
