Available - IBM Transaction Gateway for Multiplatforms V9.0

IBM Transaction Gateway for Multiplatforms V9.0 and IBM Transaction Gateway Desktop Edition V9.0 are both now generally available for electronic download. Physical availability of these products and of IBM Transaction Gateway for z/OS V9.0 will occur December 14 2012. Available - IBM Rational Test Workbench V8.0.1

Rational Integration Tester, a component of Rational Test Workbench, provides a codeless approach to service based testing and virtualization. The new release has extended the range of support to include the testing of CICS host programs through CICS Transaction Gateway; program arguments (passed using both commareas and channels) can be graphically manipulated through the application of imported copybooks and other schema based artefacts. Tests can use a variety of generated patterns of data as well as being data driven from a range of external sources. They can then be reused for performance testing. Recording of interactions with CICS Transaction Gateway can also be made which facilitates the easy creation of regression tests from existing systems. For more details see:
