Announcement: CICS Transaction Server for z/OS V5.1

IBM® CICS® Transaction Server for z/OS® (CICS TS) V5.1 is announced today, bringing increased operational efficiency and improved service agility with cloud enablement.

CICS TS V5.1 satisfies over one hundred customer requirements that help solve the two most pressing challenges that companies face today; driving operational efficiencies, while increasing service agility.

Driving operational efficiencies

- Greater capacity: achieve cost savings through consolidation
- Managed operations: control critical resource thresholds with policies
- Increased availability: reduce the need for planned downtime
- Deeper insight: extend performance and compliance information

Increasing service agility

- First-class applications: create agile services from existing assets
- First-class platforms: create agile service delivery platforms
- Modern interfaces: build rich web experiences for critical applications
- Foundational enhancements: extend core capabilities

CICS TS V5.1 delivers these capabilities in a way that positions users of CICS for the next transformational era in technology, moving them towards a service delivery platform for cloud computing.

IBM CICS Explorer, the strategic management interface for CICS TS, has been upgraded to CICS Explorer V5.1. This is a major update to support the latest CICS TS and CICS tools capabilities. CICS Explorer V5.1 will also work with other supported versions of CICS TS.

IBM has also updated five core foundational CICS tools to align with CICS TS V5.1. These tools will exploit and augment the latest operational efficiency and service agility enhancements made in CICS TS V5.1, as well as delivering valuable new capabilities for customers using current CICS TS releases.

Support for the application and platform resources introduced in CICS TS V5.1 help you to achieve value from the new version of CICS more quickly. IBM CICS Interdependency Analyzer for z/OS V5.1

CICS IA V5.1 includes application name when collecting dependency and command flow data. This lets you analyze and manage your new CICS TS applications more easily. Initial deployment of the product is simplified and data management is improved.

IBM CICS Deployment Assistant for z/OS V5.1

CICS DA V5.1 includes a new IBM System z Application Assist Processor (zAAP)-offloadable server component with enhanced discovery that creates a centralized and more complete model of your CICS infrastructure. An enhanced plug-in for IBM CICS Explorer provides advanced visualization with tagging and filtering. This lets you view, print, and manage your CICS infrastructure as you want to see it. The model can now be exported to standard spreadsheet tools for external analysis and reporting, and a sample report is provided. The centrally-managed model, with audit logging facilitates sharing, especially with large and distributed teams, and addresses key governance requirements.

Announcement: CICS Transaction Gateway V9.0

Announced today are major updates to all three members of the CICS Transaction Gateway family:

- IBM CICS Transaction Gateway for z/OS V9.0
- IBM CICS Transaction Gateway for Multiplatforms V9.0
- IBM CICS Transaction Gateway Desktop Edition V9.0

CICS TG V9.0 provides significant enhancements helping to increase operational efficiency and improve service agility. In particular:

- Exploit the latest runtime environments for distributed applications including Java 7
- Reduce complexity and management costs for high volume users with increased vertical scaling on IBM z/OS
- Extend Secure Sockets Layer (SSL) connectivity to three-tier topologies for interoperation with high availability CICS TG features
- Include connection-level time-out for users migrating from External CICS Interface (EXCI) to IP Interconnectivity (IPIC) connectivity

- Allow support for 64-bit C distributed platform External Call Interface (ECI) applications that include asynchronous calls
- Allow end-to-end transaction tracking with the WebSphere Application Server V8.5 Cross Component Trace (XCT) facility
- Full eXtended Architecture (XA) transaction meta-data for Dynamic Server Selection (DSS) algorithms eliminates the need to dedicate Gateway daemons to single lines-of-business that need high availability and two-phase commit
- Extend the recording of historical statistics to the CICS TG for Multiplatforms product

Announcement: IBM Session Manager V3.2

Announced today is IBM Session Manager V3.2, the major feature of which is an updated plug-in for IBM CICS Explorer that provides an new online administration (OLA) perspective to update configuration information including users, profiles, applications, terminal, and system parameters. This complements the operational capabilities added to the plug-in in the previous release and further reduces the need to use the ISPF interface.

If you use pass-tickets to implement session security, you can now manage them more easily using a new configuration option. This release also includes ease-of-use, security, installation, configuration, and operational enhancements, including requirements raised by individual customers and user communities, working together to make Session Manager even easier to deploy, manage, and use.
