

IBM z Systems Announcement



Today, along with announcing a new server, the IBM z13, IBM is also announcing a new family name for its System z server family. IBM System z has been renamed to IBM z Systems.

This new name will encompass every IBM Mainframe from S/360 through the new z13, and all future systems. The name change serves to signal evolution of the product line, positioning of expanding capabilities, and the role of the mainframe in the new digital era of IT.

The IBM z13 provides the infrastructure that will help differentiate you as a refined digital business. It offers the capacity and processing power to improve business performance and growth, helps better protect sensitive transactions to minimize business risk and client exposure, and it helps to deliver on service level agreements for an exceptional customer experience. New economic efficiencies allow the IBM z13 to offer more throughput and capabilities with less impact to the IT budget.

There are many exciting new features delivered by z13 which CICS customers might be able to use and benefit from, including simultaneous multithreading (SMT) on zIIP processors, cryptographic improvements, and Large Memory. CICS has also made a statement of general direction that a future release of CICS TS will support 64-bit SDK for z/OS, Java Technology Edition, Version 8 (Java 8), which itself exploits many new facilities delivered z13.

z/OS Connect now available in CICS TS V5.2

z/OS Connect provides a standards-based JSON interface to a range of IBM z Systems products including WebSphere Application Server for z/OS, IMS and now CICS TS.

This common technology is designed to allow rapid mobile and cloud enablement of existing z Systems application by using industry standard JSON web services. This will allow clients to accelerate mobile and cloud enablement projects, leveraging their significant investments in existing z



Systems applications by exposing them using JSON web services to new mobile or cloud applications.

This delivers on the promise made in the statement of direction for z/OS Connect in the CICS TS V5.2 announcement letter April 7th 2014.
