

IBM CICS

- Most of the top 50 Global banks use CICS
- Most of the fortune 100 use CICS
- 30 years and \$1 trillion invested in CICS applications (IDC)
- 10,000+ CICS mainframe licenses worldwide
- 950,000+ concurrent users/system
- 5,000 CICS software packages from 2,000 ISVs
- 950,000 programmers earn their living from CICS
- CICS handles more than 30 billion transactions/day valued at over \$1 trillion/week for 30 million end users of CICS Apps
- CICS TS v3 (SOA release) had fastest uptake of any CICS release.
 - 40% utilizing CICS Web Services capability

Large bank in China

- 30 Million Txs/Hour
- 9445 TPS
- 99.9% Txs <400 Msec
- Av Tx 200 Msec

Large Asian Bank

- 14,250 TPS
- 210 Million records deployed in <45 mins



- ▶ Task-oriented views provide integrated access to broad range of data and control capabilities
- ▶ Powerful, context-sensitive resource editors
 - Integrated in Rational Developer for System z V7.5
- Integration point for CICS TS, CICS Tools, CICS TG, PD Tools, and Rational Tools
- Extensible by ISVs, SIs, and customers




CICS Explorer helps to reduce development and admin skills

CICS Explorer SupportPacs

- CS1J: IBM CICS Explorer for Windows SupportPac
 - ▶ CICS Transaction Server for z/OS, V3.1, or later
 - Category 2 un-supported
- CS10: IBM CICS Explorer for Linux SupportPac
 - ▶ CICS Transaction Server for z/OS, V3.1, or later
 - Category 2 un-supported
- CS1N: CICS Tools Plugins for SupportPac
 - ▶ CICS Configuration Manager (CM) for z/OS V1.2
 - CICS Interdependency Analyzer (IA) for z/OS V2.2
 - CICS Performance Analyzer (PA) for z/OS V2.1
 - Category 2 un-supported
- CS1R: CICS Explorer SDK SupportPac
 - Integrate in-house, ISV, and SI tools with the CICS Explorer


