## Installation overview

- CS Windows V6.4.0 is shipped on one CD
  - ▶ QuickStart directory
    - Provides links to CS Windows information on the Web
  - ▶ Launchpad to select packages
    - View CS Windows documentation
    - Server installation
    - SNA API Client installation
    - Remote Administration Client installation

Communications Server for Windows is on one CD

CD contains

QuickStart for links to information and documentation

CS Windows documentation

Server installation directory, where InstallShield packages reside

SNAAPIClient installation directory

Remote Administration Client installation directory

## Installation overview

- To install the server, you can:
  - ▶ Change directory into the Server directory and enter “setup”
  - ▶ Start the Launchpad and select Server installation option

To install the server, change directory into the “server” directory and enter the command “setup”.

Start the Launchpad and select “Server installation option”.

CS Windows requires one of these operating systems:

- Windows XP
- Windows Server® 2003
- Windows Vista®
- Windows Server 2008

## Installation overview

The server requires a Windows 32-bit operation system

The SNA API Client and Remote Administration Client requires:

- 32-bit operating system
- 64-bit operating system, running in the 32-bit application mode

Reboot is required after the server installation

32-bit kernel Windows supported

Reboot is required after server install

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
