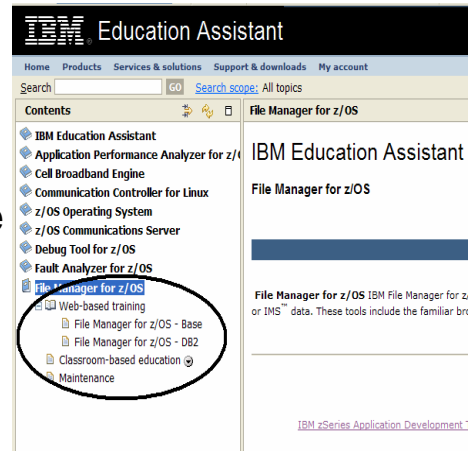

## How do I select a tutorial?

Once you have opened the IBM Education Assistant information center, you can click a product name in the left pane to expand the topic categories for that product. Then, expand the topic category that you are interested in. You can then select any topic by clicking on it.
