
Flexible Load Scenarios

- Useful for users who are migrating from other source control systems such as ClearCase
- You can
 - Load components as root folders
 - Load files and folders (Load As)
 - Load with a different name or path



Work Item History

- Work items are listed in the Team Artifacts Navigator in the order you accessed them
 - You no longer need to remember work items of interest to you, the RTC Client for Visual Studio will remember them instead.




Drag and Drop of Work Items

- You can drag and drop work items on change sets
- Also a way for you to integrate with your email or chat client

External Compare Editors

- You can now use a compare editor of your choice for comparing file versions, conflict resolutions, merges.
- We provide configurations for a few popular compare merge tools out of the box.
- You can add your own custom tool as well.
- Especially for Visual Studio developers, using a compare editor of their choice significantly improves ease of use.




Native Editors (Stream/workspace/work items)

- Has a native look and feel.





Work Item Editor

Integration with File/Folder Properties


- You can now view RTC/Jazz specific properties in the Properties View for a file.
- Edit RTC/Jazz specific Properties
- Version and compare properties



File Annotations

- Will let you figure out who modified a particular line in a source file
 - ▶ Change set comment
 - ▶ Work items
 - ▶ Modification date and time

- Jokingly referred to as 'Blame'!

Current Work Item

- A current work item is the “Active” work item for your Visual Studio session.
- Your current change set will be associated automatically with this work item
- The current work item shows up in the RTC tool bar and the status bar of the Work Items tool window.




Team Advisor

- The RTC Client for Visual Studio now has closer links to your team’s process.
- Process related errors are surfaced via “Team Advisor” instead of error pop-ups.
- Errors are accompanied by
 - ▶ The reason behind the error
 - ▶ Often links for actions to fix the error





- This will let you work directly with the files and folders in your sandbox, that may or may not be a part of your solution hierarchy.
- This will open up new ways of mapping your .NET source code to Jazz components




TOOLS INTEGRATIONS



Integration with Static Analysis Tools

- Our plan is to integrate RTC for Visual Studio with popular static analysis tools such as FxCop.
 - ▶ Running such tools would be mandated by the team's process
 - ▶ In case of errors, the team advisor view provides guidance on what went wrong.




