Introduction

Welcome to the Release Notes for IBM® WebSphere® Lombardi Edition for Microsoft® Office Add-on 7.2.0.

IBM® WebSphere® Lombardi Edition for Microsoft® Office Add-on 7.2.0, referred to in this document as Lombardi for Office, extends Business Process Management (BPM) across your entire enterprise by integrating WebSphere Lombardi Edition with familiar Microsoft Office applications.

Lombardi for Office makes it easy for anyone to participate in a business process. No special training is required, and if you are familiar with Microsoft Office, then you already have the skills you need. Lombardi for Office also enables your enterprise to get more people involved in BPM, including those who are infrequent process participants and those who need visibility into their business processes, both online and offline.

Lombardi for Office enables you to:

- Receive and run Lombardi tasks in your Outlook inbox.
- Deploy and update Lombardi for Office using standard Microsoft technologies such as Systems Management Server (SMS).
- Use single sign-on (SSO) to log on to Lombardi for Office.

What's new in Lombardi for Office

IBM® WebSphere® Lombardi Edition for Microsoft® Office Add-on 7.2.0 introduces several new features and enhancements.

- Lombardi for Office 7.2.0 supports Microsoft Office 2007 with IBM WebSphere Lombardi Edition 7.2.
- Lombardi for Office is now supported on Microsoft Windows® 7 (32-bit and 64-bit) in addition to Microsoft WindowsVista (32-bit and 64-bit) and Microsoft® Windows® XP SP2.
- The Lombardi Software BPM product names have changed for this release. Teamworks is now IBM WebSphere WebSphere Lombardi Edition. Teamworks for Office 2007 is now IBM® WebSphere® Lombardi Edition for Microsoft® Office Add-on 7.2.0, also known as Lombardi for Office.

WebSphere Lombardi Edition and Lombardi for Office provide enhanced capabilities to the IBM WebSphere portfolio.

• Lombardi for Office 7.2.0 uses a new installer.

Lombardi for Office uses the InstallShield installer instead of the InstallAnywhere installer used for Teamworks for Office 2007.

What's changed in Lombardi for Office

This release of IBM® WebSphere® Lombardi Edition for Microsoft® Office Add-on 7.2.0 introduces several changes to features that existed in Teamworks for Office 2003 and Teamworks for Office 2007.

Information about compatibility with earlier versions of the product is provided where applicable. For information about new features in this release, see What's new in Lombardi for Office.

- Lombardi for Office requires Microsoft® .Net 3.5 Service Pack 1, an update from Microsoft® .Net 3.5 which was required for Teamworks for Office 2007. If you are running Microsoft® Windows® 7, you do not have to install Microsoft® .Net 3.5 Service Pack 1 separately, as this software is already included in Windows® 7. Other versions of Windows require a download from the Microsoft website [http://www.microsoft.com/net/download.aspx].
- HTTrack is not supported.

HTTrack, an open source web crawler and offline browser, was used in Teamworks for Office 2007 to enable Microsoft® Outlook users to view ScoreBoards without a constant connection to a Teamworks server. When you are offline, Teamworks for Office 2007 caches ScoreBoards locally for offline viewing.

The offline viewing capability provided by HTTrack is not supported in Lombardi for Office.

• Infopath is not supported.

Teamworks for Office 2003 supported publishing Microsoft® InfoPath forms to an IIS server to make them available to the Teamworks Authoring Environment. This function is not supported in Lombardi for Office.
