

What is VMI?



- Product replenishment
- Purchase Order
- Forecasting

Collaborative effort

- Reduce inventory investments
- Improve Cash Flow
- Enhance value to the consumer




DI - Electronic Commerce and Beyond

VMI Overview

- Managed by a 3rd party software package
- Currently represents 18% to 20% of Kraft business
- Customers transmit 852s (Product Activity data)
- Purchase Orders generated
- * 855s (PO Acknowledgements) sent back to the customer
- Lead time consideration





How does my store's supplier participate?

Suppliers and their distributors

- Understand each other's business needs, requirements, and technical capabilities
- Establish cross-functional teams
- Establish measurement criteria

To participate with a supplier

- Electronically deliver accurate product activity information (852)
- Integrate purchase order acknowledgments (855) into their existing purchasing system

What are the benefits (besides my cheese not being out of stock)?



Supplier Benefits

- Proper lead times and consistent order frequency
- Daily analysis of the distributor's inventory levels
- An accurate daily item forecast
- Regular performance analysis tools
- Proactive steps taken by the supplier to handle delivery delays or exceptions



How about the benefits for the Distributor?

Distributor Benefits

- Maintain the lowest possible level of inventory in their distribution centers (DCs)
- Minimizes the potential for damage and/or returns
- Inventory monitored in the distributor's DC
- Generated VMI orders







Are there any additional benefits?

- More time available to build business
- Minimizes out-of-stock conditions
- Shortened lead times and order cycle times
- Provides an opportunity to improve return on assets
- Tighter customer relationships

Final Order Editing, Transmitting, and Processing





Gateway Architecture Inbound VMI Orders




Weekly Processing

End-of-week processing closes out the most recent week's collection of customer data


- Forecasting

- Service levels and turns




Gateway Architecture Forecasting - Current
