

★ Effective January 31, 2001

- DataInterchange 1.5 (and previous versions); DataInterchange 2.1
- Customers should be working now to migrate to DI 3.1
  - HOST Features
    - Pageable translation
    - Complete VSAM and DB2 Installation support
    - Allow Multiple ALPHANUM tables
  - CLIENT Features
    - Mapping Fixed-to-Fixed
    - Full Compliance checking
    - Client ported to 32-Bit
    - Allow envelope profile to be exported/imported on receive maps
    - "Where Used" function
    - Allow Multiple ALPHANUM tables
    - Export/Import of Client Maps
    - Mandatory Segments and Elements Identifier

# XML: DI 3.1 PTF



★XML: eXtensible Markup Language

- Interim support for XML
- Allows for ADF --> XML (send), and XML --> ADF (receive)
- Will allow for DTD importing
- Enabling XML as a "standard" within DI
- Allow for customer migration to 3.1 following WfS (31 JAN 2001) of 1.x, and 2.1
  - Target availability: Nov 30, 2000

### **Any-to-Any Translation**

- Looking to add any-to-any transformation capabilities along with support for a new syntax "comma separated values" (CSV)
  - Allows for translation of XML-to-XML, XML-to-EDI, EDI-to-EDI, XML-to-CSV, etc. (i.e. any combination of the data types XML, EDI, ADF and CSV)
- Looking to enhance Client interface to provide any-to-any graphical mapping with native support for storing, displaying and mapping DTD's
- ☆ Add the capability to call sub maps from within a map to handle the transmission of HL7 documents within an X12 document

### WebSphere B2B Integrator

- provides a middleware framework for the implementation of business-to-business solutions

- Powerful message-brokering software that provides real-time, intelligent rules-based message routing, and content transformation and formatting
  - Reformatting, working dynamically with the rules component, parses, maps and reformats messages by using on-the-fly conversions, transformations, and message enrichment
  - Usability features for those defining broker actions include graphical user interfaces, editable definition files, and a visual tester
  - MQSeries Integrator accommodates custom-built or predefined libraries of application templates, and e-business extensions are provided to ensure new systems are easily and quickly integrated
