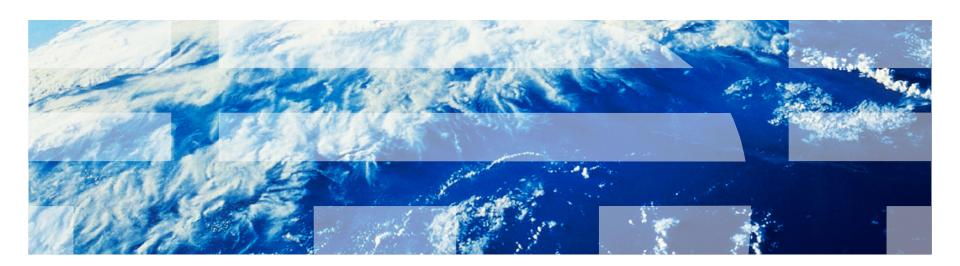

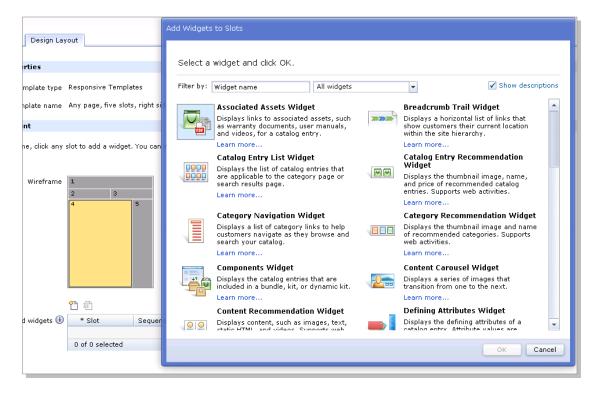

Business User Enhancements

Detailed Session:

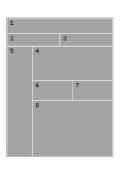
- New Management Center tool, replacing the Layout Tool to provide detailed business user control over page layout
- Business users can create and modify page layout by visually picking widgets and assigning them to slots on a page
- Direct control over the properties of individual widgets
- Click-to-edit from store preview



- functionality/tasks

- Allows business users to:
 - Create new pages
 - Landing Pages
 - Static content
 - Create new and edit existing layouts by assigning widgets to templates
 - Assign page layouts to new and existing pages
- A page layout defines assignment of various page widgets to predefined slots in a layout
- Widgets and Templates are created by IT

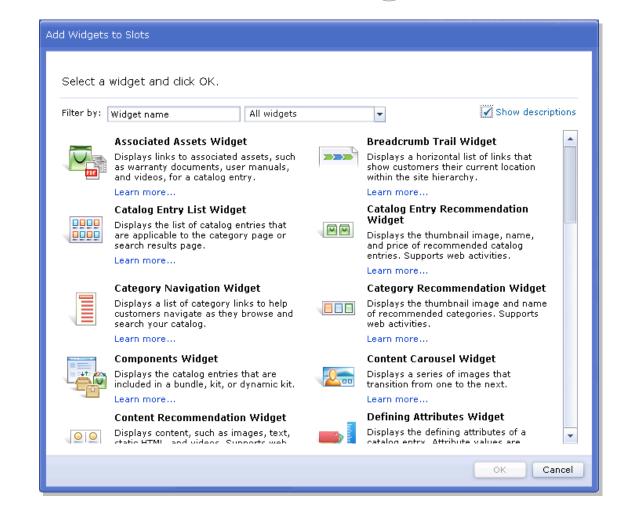

- Extension of the template/widget framework from FEP6
- New since FEP6 widgets:
 - FEP7 Widgets are registered in the DB
 - FEP7 Widgets can be defined at site-level or store-level
 - FEP6 only had store-level widgets
- Adoption:
 - New store: Start from FEP7 Aurora and customize templates and/or widgets
 - Pre-FEP6 store:
 - Create page templates matching existing layout, re-implement page functionality as custom widget ("widgetize existing store"); or
 - InfoCenter currently has steps for creating templates and widgets
 - Adopt FEP7 templates and widgets for relevant pages, possibly combining with "widgetizing"
 - InfoCenter will be amended with high-level steps for doing this within the next few months
 - FEP6-based store:
 - (optional) Move widgets to site-level
 - Change store feature to use Commer Composer instead of Template Tool
 - Register custom widgets in DB



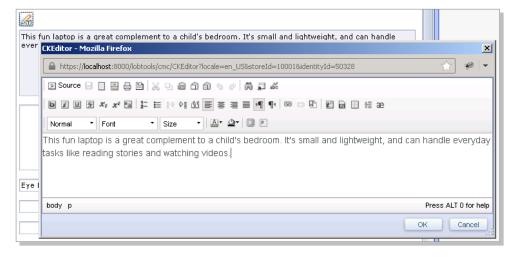
New Rich Text Editor

- The Management Center now includes a customized version of CKEditor 4.2.2.1
 - Turn on/off in user preferences
- CKEditor has features above and beyond the built-in rich text editor in Management Center, including:
 - Undo/Redo
 - Subscript/Superscript
 - Hyperlinks
 - etc.
- Limitations:
 - May cause issues with some versions of Microsoft Internet Explorer
 - Existing content may be affected when opened with CKEditor if it contains HTML that CKEditor cannot interpret

Content Manager Integration



- Introduced via an APAR in October 2013, but formally announced as part of FEP7
- Product-level integration with IBM Web Content Manager (WCM)
- Business users can assign content via punch-out actions from Management Center to WCM to assign and edit content
- JSP tag library for handling the inclusion of content
 - Content can be pulled in real-time from WCM servers when JSPs are rendered in WC
 - Content can be pushed from WCM to WC Web servers (recommended for production)

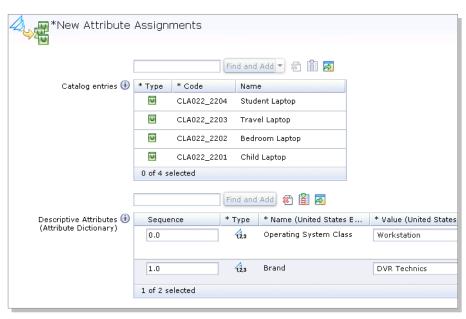


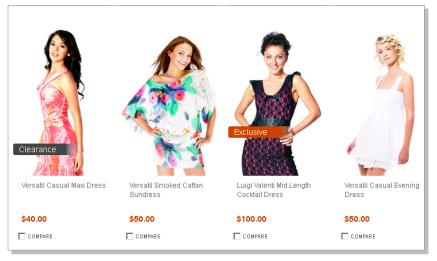


Other Management/Storefront Enhancements

- Multiple attribute selection
 - Utility function to assign the a common set of descriptive attribute values from the attribute dictionary to multiple catalog entries at the same time
 - Accessed from the Catalogs tool as
 File -> New -> Attributes Assignments
- Ribbon Ads
 - Use descriptive attributes to add ribbons to product thumbnails
 - UI easily customizable through CSS
 - Attribute name used in CSS class
 - New ribbon styles and values can be added







IBM Marketing Center Integration



- IBM Marketing Center is a cloud-based offering that allows business users to manage digital communications and to run campaigns
- FEP7 includes support for several scenarios to integrate IBM WebSphere Commerce with IBM Marketing Center:
 - Create Marketing Center campaign from WC promotion:
 - Create or select a promotion in the Promotions tool
 - Right-click promotion and select Create Campaign in IBM Marketing Center
 - Complete Marketing Center campaign
 - Export WC promotion codes to Marketing Center
 - Create or select a promotion in the Promotions tool
 - Right-click the promotion and select Export Promotion Codes
 - Select Include metadata for IBM Marketing Center
 - Open Marketing Center and import the exported codes



Omni-Channel Commerce

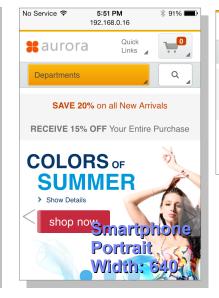
Responsive Web Design



- Responsive Web Design is a design technique that allows Web pages to fluidly resize, depending on the browser size
 - Focus on client-side resizing using CSS3 Media Queries
 - Thus, browsers need to support CSS3 for this to work
 - One set of JSPs for all RWD pages
- In FEP7, we deliver responsive browsing pages in Aurora
 - Three "breakpoints":
 - Desktop (screen widths above 1280px)
 - Tablet (screen widths between 600 and 1280px)
 - Smartphone (screen widths below 600px)
 - Pages resize as browser is resized
 - All elements are available on all resolutions
- Alleviates the maintenance of multiple JSP versions
 - No silver bullet: complexity moves from managing multiple JSPs to slightly more complex CSS

Mobile Enhancements



- No need for smartphone- or tablet-specific store archives, as RWD pages are rendered on all devices
- Worklight application works with RWD store as-is
- Non-responsive pages render using dedicated smartphone-sized JSPs rendered using server-side user agent detection

Order Management Integration



- Direct integration between WC V7 FEP7 and OMS 9.3
 - Dependency on IBM WebSphere ESB (WESB) from previous versions eliminated
- Still possible to use middleware for integration, if needed
 - IBM Integration Bus Retail Pack can be used as a separately licensed component
- WC invokes services calls directly to OMS using the Service Definition Framework (SDF)
 - Custom SOAP servlets to handle WC calls
 - OMS does translation between WC and OMS message format
 - ValueMapXSLTranslator
- OMS invokes service calls to WC using WC message format
 - Internal InvokeWebService OMS component to build and call WC services

REST Enhancements – Overview



Goals:

- Strengthen REST API coverage, performance, and consumability and align with the Smarter Commerce Strategy
- Respond to requirements/feedback from a few channels:
 - Content Management System integration
 - Separated Search and Store deployment
 - Mobile and other 3rd-party client applications

REST Foundation Improvements

- Infrastructure: Adding support for REST over Controller Commands/Databeans
- Performance: Cache filter improvements, local object cache
- Security: REST Interoperability, Partial Authentication, Multiple sessions

REST API Coverage

- Browsing/Navigation: New catalog API, dynamic price
- Cart/Order/Price: quick checkout, merge carts, customization fields, lock/unlock order, entitled price
- Marketing: customer segment, marketing spot, Web activity (espot) data, dialog activity (event handler)

REST Enhancements – Details



- Support for mapping REST calls to Controller Commands and Data Beans
- New handlers:
 - AssignedCouponHandler CRUD coupons for current cart
 - AssignedPromotionCodeHandler CRUD promotion codes for current cart
 - AssociatedPromotionHandler read promotions for current cart
 - CouponHandler manipulate user's coupon wallet
 - PreviewTokenHandler generate preview token
 - PriceHandler retrieve entitled and range prices for a product/contract combination
 - PromotionHandler retrieve promotion details for a given promotion or a list of promotions
 - SegmentHandler retrieve customer segment information
 - SiteContentHandler retrieve static content from the serch server
 - SpotHandler read espot details
- Support for personalization ID in all calls
- Search services amended with new lightweight Search-related REST services exposed on the Search servers
 - Previous search BOD-based REST search services are still available

WC Search Enhancements



Architecture

- Exposing search REST services directly from the Search servers
- Search and browse processing can be handled mostly by search servers
- Increased separate scalability of search layer vs transactional layer

Programming Model

- Simplified programming model used on Search servers
 - No EJBs, BODs, or controller commands
- Search providers run exclusively on search server

Performance

- Most processing of search requests done on Search servers, offloading WC servers
- Search processing simplified due to lightweight processing framework on Search servers
- WC servers focus on transactional processing

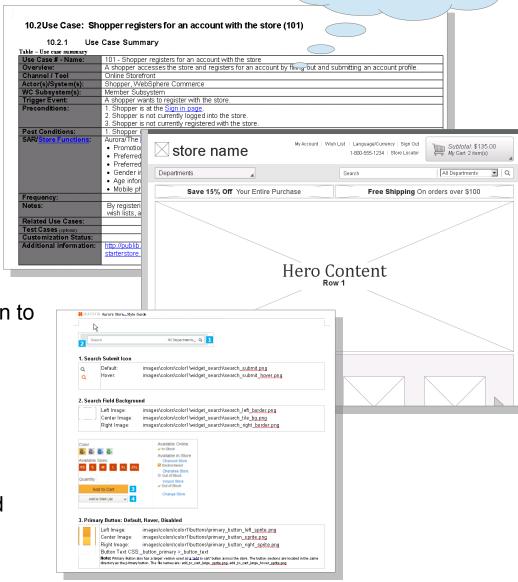
Compatibility

- FEP7 Aurora uses the new search REST services that are served directly from the Search servers
- The search services used in FEP2-6 are still available and supported for existing stores

- FEP7 requires WC 7.0.0.8+ (FP8+)
 - WC 7.0.0.8 requires WAS 7.0.0.29+ (FP29+)
- WC Search in FEP7 uses Apache Solr 4.3.0
- Worklight Support updated to V6:
 - IBM Worklight Consumer Edition Version 6.0.0
 - IBM Worklight Enterprise Edition Version 6.0.0
- Support and entitlement for IBM DB2 10.1 and 10.5
- Support for:
 - IBM DB2 10.5 pureScale on AIX
 - PureData System for Transactions FP3
- Limited-use license for IBM Tealeaf CX 8.8 and IBM Tealeaf cxImpact 8.8 in test environments
 - Aurora checkout pages preconfigured for Tealeaf Customer Experience
- Additional language support (Aurora translated to):
 - Arabic
 - Turkish

Security Improvements



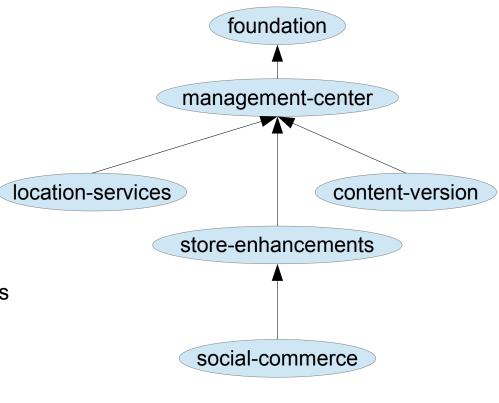
- Ability to optionally comply to National Institute of Standards and Technology (NIST) Special Publication (SP) 800-131A:
 - NIST SP 800-131A offers guidance to migrate to the use of stronger cryptographic keys and more robust algorithms
 - Becomes mandatory for US Federal customers beginning in 2014
 - Checklist contains many elements, including:
 - Strength of encryption keys, hashing algorithm, random number generator, certificate key strength, TLS 1.2, etc.
- Changes in FEP7:
 - Added support to optionally use 128 bit AES encryption (instead of Triple DES)
 - Added support to optionally use SHA-256 for hashing of new information, e.g. passwords, instead of SHA-1
