

#### <u>Trust</u> and <u>Relationship</u> are key to driving revenue


Forrester projects that online business trade will hit \$2.7 trillion by 2004 with 53% of trade transacted through eMarketplace

# Java Access to Domino User Identity

- Via Local Domino Java classes
  - Server authority
  - NotesFactory.createSession()
- Via Local Domino Java or CORBA classes
  - User authority
  - NotesFactory.createSession(host,username,password)



#### New features

#### Common Cookie for Single Sign-On (SSO)


- New multi-server option for session authentication
  - New SSO configuration document
  - WebSphere secret key is encrypted with Domino public key
  - -Requires WebSphere in secure mode, WebSphere LTPA
  - Domino can provide LDAP repository for user definitions, passwords, certificates

### New Java API options for authenticated invocation

- Shared sessions and calls carry user's authenticated identity
- Requires SSO setup as above



### Java Integration



#### **Agents:**




- Access to Lotus object model and collaborative services
- Written in LotusScript (BASIC) or Java
- Full access to Domino services
- Loaded in memory each run
- Honors all Domino security including roles

#### **Java Tools:**

- Full Java API to object model
- Support for imported or in-place Java code
- View, outline, action, text editor applets
- Java Lotus Connectors
- Java XML Parser
- Java XSL Stylesheet Processor



### Servlet Engine Integration







- Standard Server-based Java Program
- Successor to CGI and NSAPI/ISAPI Programs
- Stays resident in memory
- Can load on HTTP startup
- Accesses HTTP parameters, session state and cookies

#### Next Features (proposed)

#### JSPs

- Java Server Pages (JSPs) are a server-side scripting framework for the Web
- Dynamic page generation, separates HTML authoring from coding function

#### JSP Support for LotusScript

- Phase 1: JSPs hosted in WebSphere have access to LotusScript classes and methods
- Phase 2: Domino supports JSPs in LotusScript

#### LotusScript

- Becomes pervasive programming model within the WebSphere family of offerings
- Offers a BASIC programming model to complement or substitute for Java
  - Opens WebSphere to LotusScript and Visual BASIC (Windows) developers
- Enterprise Solutions Builder (ESB) technology leveraged to deliver LotusScript with or without Domino





### **EJB Integration**

#### Enterprise Java Beans (EJBs)

- A competitor to MTS
- A specification for enterprise transactional applications based on java

#### Domino calling EJBs


- Invoke EJB logic from a Domino <u>Java</u> Agent
- Invoke EJB logic indirectly through a servlet or JSP

#### EJBs calling Domino

- Java Objects (local)
- CORBA Objects (remote)
- JDBC
