

IBM WebSphere Business Integrator Version 2 Release 1



IBM WebSphere® Business Integrator Version 2.1 provides end-to-end business process integration. It enables companies and systems integrators to create, execute and manage processes that span diverse applications and enterprises and to manage those processes as well as the underlying IT components as a single, complete, flexible solution.

WebSphere Business Integrator is particularly relevant for those participating in e-market places. It reduces the time, complexity and cost of implementing new enterprise application solutions, and once implemented, helps to enable dynamic changes to processes in order to meet new business needs.

Greater control and competitive advantage

As a result, it helps companies to become more attractive to do business with, to achieve greater control of their value chain and so gain competitive advantage in providing their consumers with a consistent experience across a range of channels, to reduce inventory costs by improving supplier integration and to realise merger benefits by communicating across diverse systems.

In addition, IBM's patented process management capability separates the 'what' from the 'how' in terms of choreographing the lifecycle of a business process document and those process execution activity-flows in which the document participates. The result is an adaptive, event-driven platform that makes it possible to realise more sophisticated elements of the particular business problem being modeled.

- MQSeries Workflow, a business process management system, enables the definition, execution and swift change of complete business processes that span systems, applications and people.
- IBM SecureWay Directory is a highly scaleable Lightweight Directory Access Protocol (LDAP) that provides a common directory enabling customers to address the proliferation of application-specific directories.

- Tivoli SecureWay Policy Director provides access control management that centralizes network and application security policy across e-business and distributed applications.
