Please note that no changes have been made to the Passport Advantage Enrollment Forms in connection with these program updates.

For **all new Passport Advantage Express transactions** on or after September 8, 2008, the new version of the Attachment for Sub-Capacity Licensing Terms (Z125-7174-02), dated July 2008 has been and must continue to be used – please ensure you provide your customers with this new version of the Attachment, and please cease use of the prior version as of that date.

In brief, here are the changes being made to sub-capacity terms for Passport Advantage and Passport Advantage Express:

- Elimination of Registration and Reporting
- O New and improved IBM License Metric Tool replaces ITLCM for IBM Software
- o Expansion of Eligible Virtualization Environments, including VMware
- Clarification of compliance verification rights and obligations

In addition, the list of PVU-based products eligible for sub-capacity licensing has been expanded. We have also eliminated the requirement to obtain and track a different part number for sub-capacity licensing.
