- Shorten the lag time between an event's occurrence and the recording of that event in the system. There's no need to wait until you get back to your desk to enter or retrieve data.
- Increase accuracy of data in the system by allowing users to enter information while it's fresh in their minds.
- Offer convenient, targeted access to Maximo for workers who don't regularly sit at a desk or use a desktop computer.

The new viewing window in IBM Maximo Application Designer indicates the viewable area on an iPhone and is configurable for the devices you use.



With Maximo Everyplace, you can use the Safari browser on your iPhone or iPod touch to interact with the Maximo system that you use at your desk. Maximo Everyplace adds extra configuration functionality, such as a window in the Application Designer that shows you how much of the screen you will see on the iPhone and an alternative look to use on your applications. Bigger buttons and redesigned user-interface controls make it easier to interact with Maximo on a touch screen. And, any applications that you design using these features are not limited to being used on an iPhone; they can be accessed and used on any device that uses a Maximo-supported browser, like IE 6 or 7. You could use the same application on your desktop machine, tablets, and an iPhone.

Creating useful Maximo applications with Maximo Everyplace is simple. Just follow these steps:

- Know which users will need access and what those users need to be able to do
- Start with an existing application, for example, Work Order Tracking
- Clone the existing application and use the iPhone-sized window in the Application Designer to remove any functionality that you don't need on the handheld device

 Choose the look that is most appropriate for your application from the provided options, such as bigger buttons, alternative controls, and a smaller banner

All the existing Maximo functionality is available in Maximo Everyplace. All the Application Designer features are also available. Maximo Everyplace gives you the tools that you need to apply Maximo functionality to your iPhone, iPod touch and any supported device, without installing anything on those devices.
