

Take M1 South towards city centre and join M50 Southbound.

Use Exit 6 (N3 / Navan) and get on N3 towards Navan.

Take Exit 4 from N3, turn right at the exit ramp to cross over N3.

Proceed straight, use Exit 2 at the roundabout (Damastawn Road).

You will then come up to the IBM entrance gate.

Follow signs for **N3** towards Navan/Cavan from city center.

Take **Exit 4 from N3**, turn right at the exit ramp to cross over N3.
