The power of IBM Datacap Taskmaster intelligent document capture software for extracting invoice data and direct reconciliation with SAP PO data is complemented by the intelligent processing of the invoice by xft invoice manager, which can even handle partial deliveries and individually settled PO items.




Figure 1: The Datacap accounts payable capture panel shows image and extracted data, including line items.




Figure 2: The purchase order line reconciliation feature in Datacap software enables matching of PO line items with invoice line items. The system automatically matches obviously identical line items and is designed to enable the verify operator to easily click and match line items that may differ in description but are actually equivalent.




Figure 3: Invoice image and accurate data appear in the xft approval workflow interface, which helps make invoice routing to the assigned approver fast and efficient.




Figure 4: Datacap capture panels show the image on the right and the extracted data from the key fields on the left. Notice the mix of machine-printed and hand-printed type.




Figure 5: Employee data is extracted from HR documents by Datacap and mapped to the correct fields in the xft's personnel file interface.

Processing of new invoice forms can be done on the fly without additional training or custom programming. New vendors are added through a fast and simple point-and-click method that takes less than a minute per new invoice. Line items are accurately extracted, even on multiple page invoices, and the purchase order line reconciliation (POLR) feature presents invoice line items next to PO line items from SAP. Because IBM Datacap supports most global languages and their corresponding date and currency formats, it can also be used for multilanguage invoices and supporting documentation.




Figure 6: SAP clients can take advantage of automated validations. In the above example, the solution is matching the number against a database of member numbers, and it is flagging a mismatch. The quality assurance operator makes the correction and fixes the error at the capture stage.
