Starting and Ending PerfectPhoto

When installation is complete, the IBM PerfectPhoto menu item is added to **Programs** in the **Start** menu.

- ▶ To start PerfectPhoto:
 - 1. Click the **Start** button in the Windows task bar.
 - 2. In the Programs menu, click **IBM PerfectPhoto** then **PerfectPhoto**.


- If you prefer a tour of IBM PerfectPhoto, the tutorial will provide you with an overview of the program's features and some great hints and tips.

 - 2. In the Programs menu, click IBM PerfectPhoto then Tutorial.

Loading Images from a Digital Camera and Scanner

The **Album Explorer** is used for organizing and managing images. Images are stored into an album and the albums are stored into a bookshelf.

- To load images from a digital camera or scanner:
 - 1. **Connect** your digital camera or scanner to your computer with a cable.
 - 2. **Open** Album Explorer.

Note: You must install the appropriate device driver before you connect your digital camera. See the manual that came with your TWAIN device.

[TWAIN is the international protocol for image input devices.]

- 3. From the Operation bar, click the **TWAIN** icon.
- 4. In the Select TWAIN Device and Import Image dialog, select an appropriate TWAIN device driver for the device connected to your computer, and click Open Image.

The Create an Album dialog is displayed.

5. Specify the folder and click **OK**.

An album is created automatically, and the TWAIN driver starts.


6. See the manual that came with your TWAIN device and load the images.

The thumbnails of the loaded images are displayed in your album window. ▶



Correcting and Enhancing Images


Image Editor is a program for editing digital images. You can enhance images imported from a digital camera or scanner and create your own posters or calendars.



You can use Image Editor to:

- Adjust the color or brightness.
- Convert image types
- Add effects. Image Editor provides Retouch Navigation, which makes enhancing images easy. You can also use templates.
- Paste part of an image onto another image using the layer function.
- Produce an enhanced image in a variety of formats, such as a poster, an HTML file for your Web page, or a Slide Show.

For example, you can correct the brightness of an image as follows:



	Things you can do to correct your images
	Hue : Corrects the brightness and hue of a color.
1	Brightness/Contrast: Adjusts the brightness and contrast.
dia	Level: Corrects the brightness of an image using a histogram.
A	Tone Curve: Corrects the brightness of an image.
•	Red Eyes: Corrects red eyes.
##	Resolution: Corrects resolution.
	Trim : Deletes areas that are outside the selected area.
땹	Paper size: Changes the size of the base to which layers are pasted.
₽	Rotation: Rotates or flips the image.
	Things you can do to enhance your images
<u>1</u> 1	Effect Pallet: Enables you to add special effects.
*	Brush : Allows you to draw lines and shapes with a brush using the mouse.
	Paint: Paints the color at the point clicked using the foreground color in the tool pallet.
	Gradation : Adds a gradation effect to the selected area.
1	Shadow : Adds shadows to the selected images or text.
Α	Text: Allows you to enter text at the selected area.
Z	Transformation : Reshapes the selected layer. You can select size, angle, or parallelogram.
*	Navigation : Enables you to select the enhancement you want to make from the samples.
<u></u>	Tool Pallet: Selects the area and color you want to enhance.
?	Zoom Pallet: Zooms in an area where you want to do detailed work.
#	Layer Pallet: Creates layers and changes layer settings.
F	History Pallet: Saves the history of changes made to an image and applies them to others.

▶ **Note:** To display text under the Operation bar icons, click **View** from the Menu bar, click **Operation bar**, and then click **Text**.

Sharing Your Digital Image Collection

Gallery Editor is a program for creating a digital gallery from an image collection. Your images can be presented in six moving views: clouds, earth, tornado, tatami, river, and spiral.

- To create a digital gallery:
 - 1. **Open** Windows Explorer or PerfectPhoto Album Explorer.
 - 2. **Open** the folder or album that contains the image you want to use.
 - 3. Drag and drop the image into Gallery Editor. The image is registered in a gallery as a frame.
 - 4. From the Operation bar, select the **Save** icon. The Save As dialog is displayed.
 - 5. Specify the directory and click **Save**.



Gallery Editor ▲

- To view your digital gallery:
 - 1. From the Operation bar, click the **Open gallery** icon. The Open dialog is displayed.
 - 2. Specify a digital gallery file (.DPG) and click **Open**. The frames are arranged in thumbnails.
 - 3. From the Operation bar, click the **Start digital gallery** icon.

Your digital gallery is displayed. ▶

- To change the way the gallery is displayed:
 - Click the **screen** with the right mouse button. The popup menu is displayed.
 - 2. Click one of the views.

 - 1. Click IBM PerfectPhoto from the Programs menu.

 - Move the mouse over the icon whose tooltip you wish to display.
 A popup tooltip displays a two or three word description of the Operation bar icon.
 The status bar at the bottom of the window displays a descriptive message.
