






Status of recent Business Requests as depicted in Rational Focal Point

Bank **DnB NORD**

Need: Bank DnB NORD was facing the challenge of replacing core banking systems with project data stored in numerous documents, spread sheets and systems and project teams working at sites across several countries.

Solution: Implemented IBM Rational Focal Point to handle project management, portfolio management, vendor management and resource management, as well as to provide detailed management information for decision support across the whole core banking replacement program.

Benefits: Cut time to create a full status report on projects from 70 hours to just 1.5 hours. Improved visibility of real-time project data, enhancing management control and assisting with accurate decision-making. Reduced administrative effort in the project management office, freeing up two full-time employees for more productive work.

This bank in North America has four main areas of focus: monetary policy, currency, financial systems and funds management.

Business need:

This bank continually strives to improve efficiency and agility. It sought to gain a clearer picture of all the applications it was supporting to minimize redundancy and lower costs.

Solution:

The bank used IBM Rational Focal Point software to develop an overview of its current technology roadmap and identify dependencies between applications.

Benefits:

The bank reduced the number of service level agreements (SLAs) it maintains from 17 to four and cut the number of supported applications from 600 to 147, increasing IT department productivity.





Financial management technology provider

Need: Significant business growth resulted in a number of challenges with the provider's Microsoft-based software development environment. Source code held in Visual Source Safe was scattered throughout the company's network with no centralized management of software assets, making it difficult to obtain inventory. Disconnected development tools made it difficult to manage developer activities and collect measurements for improved decision making.

Solution: The company adopted IBM Rational Team Concert Standard and IBM Rational Quality Manager to improve its software development and delivery processes and deliver improved software quality to the business. Based on the IBM Rational Jazz technology platform for collaborative software delivery, Rational Team Concert and Rational Quality Manager empower the company's software development team to simplify, automate and govern its software delivery process.

Benefits: Baselines enable developers to save time and money by "switching back" to an earlier baseline to recover lost code or run a build based on it · Ability to share code between repository workspaces helps improve productivity · Team dashboards allow management to see individual and team workloads, enabling more appropriate and efficient delegation of tasks · Real-time reporting improves communication on the status of projects between business units

In Summary

We are seeing an increase in focus on delivering business services and not just rolling out new software. Business owners have a far greater say in these scenarios.

Changing business demand is putting more focus on improving development efficiency and putting the emphasis on agility.

Using the IPDF Framework locally in ASEAN we have a staged approach to deploying new business capabilities quickly and effectively.
