New report without resource utilization

A new report is added under **Multi Reporting Templates** group that does not include the **Resource Utilization**. Eliminating Resource Utilization makes the report to load faster. This new report includes:

- General Health
- Timephased Budgets
- WBS Elements with Attributes
- Scope Management

Circumventing 2 minute transaction timeout set on Proxy servers

For transactions that might take more than 2 minutes, Rational Portfolio Manager will keep the channel alive by transmitting keep-alive messages until all the data is ready.
