This document describes how to install the Rational Unified Process® or RUP® product using use the Rational Software Setup wizard, which is used to install all of the Rational Software Windows tools.

This release of RUP includes RUP Builder, which allows process managers to customize their RUP processes by using previously built plug-ins, including Microsoft and IBM, and by creating their own configurations, comprised of a base process and a selection of plug-ins.

This guide is intended for all readers, including managers, project leaders, analysts, developers, testers, and system administrators who will be installing this product.

Installing the Rational Unified Process

Hardware and Software Requirements

System Requirements

Any Pentium-based PC-compatible computer system with:

- SVGA-compatible display
- Any pointing device with at least two buttons
- Microsoft Windows 98 SE, ME, 2000 (SP 1, 2), XP, or NT 4.0 (SP6a)
- 32 MB RAM
- 225 MB disk space

Required Supporting Software

Either of the following supporting software is required:

- Microsoft Internet Explorer 5.01 with SP2 or later
- Netscape Navigator version 4.72 or later.

Note: RUP does not support Netscape version 6.x at this time.

Installing the Rational Unified Process

When you install RUP, you install the RUP Builder, the Process Repository, and the default Classic RUP¹ on the file system. The Process Repository includes the RUP content library, the base process, the Rational process plug-ins, and a set of predefined process configurations. RUP Builder lets you select a particular process configuration or create a new one from the plug-ins provided. A process configuration can then be published as a Web site.

^{1.} Classic RUP includes the base RUP process model, and business modeling and real-time plug-ins.

RUP Builder can also be installed as part of the Rational® Suite install. That installation procedure is not described here. For information on this topic, please see the *Rational*® *Suite Installation Guide*.

- 1 Insert the installation CD into your system's CD drive.
- 2 The Rational Software Setup wizard will guide you through the software installation. Click **Next** to proceed to the next screen in steps **3** through **7**.
- **3** On the first screen, click **Next** to continue.
- 4 On the screen titled Choose Product, click Rational Unified Process.
- 5 On the screen titled License Agreement, click Yes, I accept the agreement.
- 6 On the screen titled Select Configuration, click **Typical**.
- 7 On the screen titled Upgrade Compatibility, click Next.

Note: This screen only appears if you've previously installed a Rational product.

8 On the screen titled Confirmation, click **Next** to start the file copying process.

The system installs the RUP Builder, the Process Repository, and the default Classic RUP on the file system.

- 9 On the screen titled Restart Windows, select Restart and click Finish.
- 10 When the system restarts, you must use the same administrator identity to log in.

The system adds the Rational program group section to the **Start** menu and links to the RUP Builder and the default Classic RUP.

11 On the screen titled Installation Complete, click Finish.

Uninstalling the RUP

Due to limitations of the Installer, some manual steps are required to uninstall the RUP:

- 1 From the Windows Control Panel, click **Add/Remove Programs**.
- 2 On the tab labelled Install/Uninstall, locate and click Rational Unified Process.
- 3 Click **Add/Remove** and follow the prompts. (Errors are expected.)
- 4 On the screen titled Confirmation, click Next.
- 5 On the screen titled Restart Windows, select **Restart** and click **Finish**.
- 6 When the system restarts, you must use the same administrator identity to log in.

- 7 Start Windows Explorer.
- 8 Browse to the location where you installed the RUP.

The default location is C:\Program Files\Rational\RationalUnifiedProcess.

If a folder titled RationalUnifiedProcess still resides in the Rational directory, delete the entire folder.

Release Notes

There are two ways you can access the RUP release notes:

- View the file relnotes.htm, stored on the installation CD in the RationalUnifiedProcess directory.
- Alternatively, after installation you can open the Windows Start menu, and select Programs > Rational Unified Process > Release Notes.
