Required Supporting Software

We recommend you use Netscape Navigator version 4.72 or later.

Note: RUP does not support Netscape version 6.x at this time.

Installing the RUP from the RUP UNIX CD

The installation procedure extracts the selected variant “.tar” file on your hard drive. It creates directories for both the RUP and the Project Web Site example.

Installing the Classic RUP

- 1 Create a directory on your hard drive where you want to install Rational products (for example, ../rational)
- 2 Copy the compressed tar file “rup_2002_05_00_classic.tar” from the RUP UNIX CD to the directory created in step 1. Extract the compressed tar file “rup_2002_05_00_classic.tar” as follows:

```
tar -xvf rup_2002_05_00_classic.tar
```
- 3 To start the RUP, open the following file:
.../rational/rup_2002_05_00_classic/index.htm

Installing the RUP with IBM content for e-business

- 1 Create a directory on your hard drive where you want to install Rational products (for example, ../rational)
- 2 Copy the compressed tar file “rup_2002_05_00_ibm.tar” from the RUP UNIX CD to the directory created in step 1. Extract the compressed tar file “rup_2002_05_00_ibm.tar” as follows:

```
tar -xvf rup_2002_05_00_ibm.tar
```

- 3 To start the RUP, open the following file:
../rational/rup_2002_05_00_ibm/index.htm

Installing the RUP with content for the Microsoft Web Solution Platform

- 1 Create a directory on your hard drive where you want to install Rational products; for example, ../rational.
- 2 Copy the compressed tar file “rup_2002_05_00_msft.tar” from the RUP UNIX CD to the directory created in step 1. Extract the compressed tar file “rup_2002_05_00_msft.tar” as follows:

```
tar -xvf rup_2002_05_00_msft.tar
```

- 3 To start the RUP open the following file:
../rational/rup_2002_05_00_msft/index.htm

Installing the RUP from the Rational® Suite UNIX CD

Note: You need a Rational License Key to install from this CD, which is included.

- 1 Create a directory on your hard drive where you want to install the Rational products; for example, ../rational.
- 2 Locate and run the shell script `rs_install` from the Rational Suite UNIX CD.
- 3 Follow the instructions displayed on screen.
- 4 From the **Product and License Configuration Selection** menu, click item 1) **Rational Suite Development Studio**. Continue to follow the installation instructions displayed on screen.
- 5 On the **Development Studio — Product Customization** menu, items 5), 6), and 7) represent the RUP variants available for installation. Select the RUP variant or variants you want and proceed with the installation.

- 6 The installation process creates the folder RUP_XXX.2002.05.00¹ in the previously created Rational directory (see step 1).
- 7 To start the RUP, open the following file:
`../rational/releases/RUP_XXX.2002.05.00/RationalUnifiedProcess/index.htm`

1. The series xxx refers to RUP classic, ibm, or msft, depending on what you chose to install.
