Installing the Rational Unified Process

The Rational Unified Process is installable from the Unix CD v2003.06.00 that came with your RUP or Rational Suites package.

- 1 Create a directory for Rational products.
- 2 Run the rs_install batch file from the CD
- **3** A set of preliminary instructions for navigating through the installation is provided. Press "Enter" to continue.
- 4 Details on install location is given. Press "Enter" to continue.
- **5** If previous Rational products has been installed, their location will be displayed. Select "0" to choose a new install location, and provide the full path to the directory created in step 1, e.g. "/space/home/username/Rational"
- **6** The Rational License aggrement is displayed. After reading through the agreement, press "Yes" to continue with the installation, and "No" to quit the installation.
- 7 Press "Yes" if you wish to see this license agreement next time you install a Rational Product. Press "No" otherwise.
- **8** The Third Party License aggreement is displayed. After reading through the agreement, press "Yes" to continue with the installation, and "No" to quit the installation.
- **9** Select from the list of products, "Rational Unified Process". Note, Rational Unified Process is also installed when you select the Rational Suite Development Studio for Unix product.
- **10** Once everything has been installed go to the top level directory (in our case Rational) and type either:
 - source rs_setup.csh" (for csh) OR
 - ". rs_setup.ksh" (for ksh)

This will set the environment for running the Suite and will enable commands that can be used with the Rational applications.

The above instructions apply primarily when installing RUP and RUP Builder from a Rational Suite UNIX CD. For instructions of how to install RUP and RUP Builder from a point product CD, please refer to the README file included on that CD.
